The application must be in duplicate and accompanied by three unmounted photographs of the applicant, not larger than 3 by 3 inches in size. The photographs must be on thin paper and should have a light background. All should be signed by the applicant across the face of the photograph, so as not to obscure the features, if the applicant is able to write. This blank must be completely filled out.

FORM OF CERTIFICATE TO BE GIVEN BY PERSONS STANDING SPONSOR FOR AN APPLICANT FOR A PERMIT TO ENTER A FORBIDDEN AREA UNDER REGULATION NO. 4 OF THE PRESIDENT'S PROCLAMATION OF APRIL 6, 1917.

WHEREAS Caroline Pagel has made application for a permit to come within an area of one-half mile radius from all zones in R.C. Kansas, under Regulation No. 4 of the President's Proclamation of April 6, 1917,

I, Frank M. Dolcomb, a citizen of the United States, residing at R.C. Kan do hereby certify:

That I have known the said Caroline Pagel for 10 years and _____ months in such a manner that I can vouch for his good behavior; that I believe that the statements made in the application of the said Caroline Pagel are true; that I know of nothing concerning him which would lead me to suspect that his use of the permit applied for will cause, or tend to cause, any violation of any law of the United States or of any State, Territory, or possession thereof, or of the President's Proclamation of April 6, 1917, or in any way injure the United States in the prosecution of the war in which it is engaged.

If permit is issued to Caroline Pagel I, Frank M. Dolcomb agree to take every reasonable precaution to see that he fulfills the obligations assumed in the application, and I further agree that if I learn of anything tending to show that he is not using his permit in good faith, or is not fulfilling the obligations assumed in the application, or is engaging in any activity detrimental to the United States, I will at once notify the United States Marshal.
