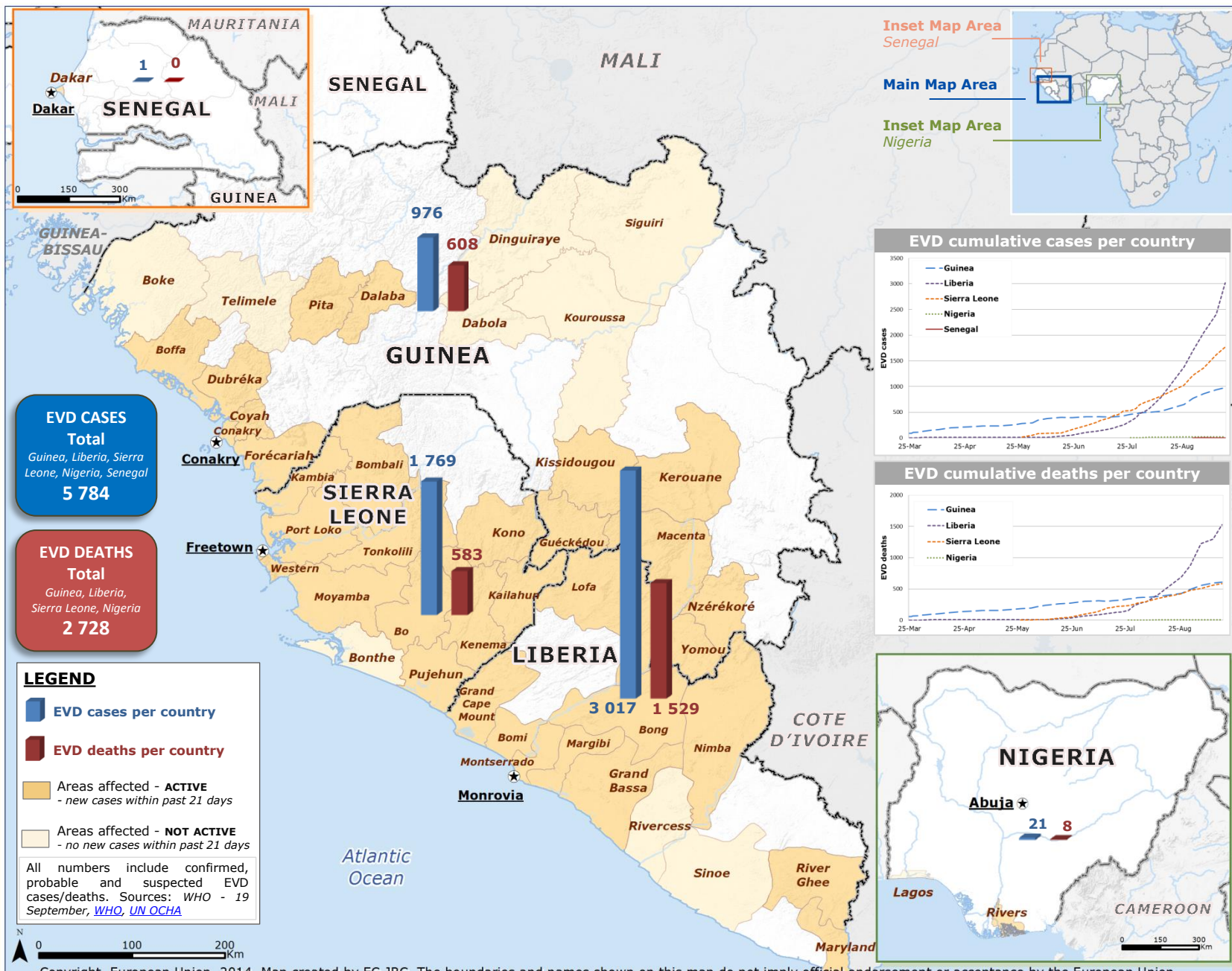


22 September 2014: West Africa - Ebola Virus Disease (EVD) Outbreak



SITUATION

- The total number of new cases and deaths attributable to the **Ebola Virus Disease (EVD)** is still increasing in the five affected West African countries of **Liberia, Sierra Leone, Guinea, Nigeria** and **Senegal**. As of 19 September (WHO), there were 5 784 people infected and 2 728 dead (probable and suspected cases included).
- In **Liberia**, the continued increase in the number of cases is mostly due to the continued increase reported in the capital **Monrovia (Montserrado)**. The majority of the recent deaths were in **Montserrado**.
- Regarding the **unrelated EVD outbreak**, in the Democratic Republic of Congo, no new cases and deaths were reported (as of 19 September). 71 cases and 40 deaths have been reported.
