1. One of the greatest obstacles to the reforestation of cutover areas is the forest owners' shortages of funds. This shortage in a large percentage of cases may be traced directly to the tardiness of coal mine owners in settling their bills for mine timbers.

2. A survey of approximately two thirds of Kagoshima timber shippers indicates that they are owed ¥95, 275, 207.82 by Northern Kyushu operators alone.

3. In many cases, the last partial payment on the accounts were made as long ago as April 1948.

4. Until they can collect from the mine owners, the shippers declare it is impossible to pay what they owe to the forest owners.

5. A partial list of the outstanding indebtedness of the mines is enclosed.

6. Action is requested to expedite payment as a partial means of easing Kagoshima's present financial stringency.

1. The indebtedness of mines to various suppliers, particularly suppliers of mining machinery and mining timbers, is rapidly reaching a critical stage which threatens bankruptcy of many of these supply agencies. This situation was aggravated in February due to the fact that through an alleged "misunderstanding" the mines failed to make even the usual payments in January to mining timber producers. Following the lead of Hokkaido timber producers, Kyushu timber producers proposed a meeting on 21 February at which time they planned to take action to halt shipments of timbers to mines if payments were not met.

2. In order to prevent this situation from becoming too critical, military government discussed the matter with the association of mine owners, and they agreed that individual mines would pay from 75% to 90% of their indebtedness to timber suppliers dating back to January 1, 1949. They offered further to pay back the entire debt at the rate of 5% per month. While this undoubtedly will not be entirely satisfactory to timber producers, it is believed it will prevent any real stoppage of supply at this time. Mine management and timber suppliers will meet in the near future in an effort to reach an equitable settlement.

3. The plan of the Coal Production Committee to have ¥400,000,000 of the amount paid by coal consumers diverted monthly during January, February and March from the mines to the supply agencies to pay back-debts is not being carried out in Kyushu. In fact, all agencies concerned claimed that they received very ambiguous information about the plan, and that it could not be carried out for the following reasons:

a. Mines will not agree to it, and other agencies concerned say the plan has no legal foundation which could be used to force mines to comply.

b. Mines claim they cannot meet miners' wages if these funds are diverted and that labor and production troubles would result. It is true that many mines are only meeting 80% of payrolls at the present time, the remaining payments being deferred "until money is available".

4. Since basic letter presents figures showing indebted-

5. It is known that higher headquarters are generally informed of the critical financial situation outlined above and are striving to reach a solution. Unfortunately, due to the nature of bookkeeping in mines, there is no one expert enough to say whether this financial situation is unavoidable or is being deliberately created and fostered in order to promote a higher coal price and also to force additional subsidies to mines despite the three-point program of control. There is much evidence that deliberate calculation and irregular bookkeeping are playing an important role in this "crisis" and that

no strong program of rationalization has yet been undertaken by the mines to cut production costs.

6. This report is forwarded for information of higher headquarters now striving to reach a solution of the problems involved. A prompt solution is necessary to prevent bankruptcy of some supply agencies and to assure a steady supply of materials to mines.
