The Union has already broken up one summer school session and there is documentary evidence indicating all schools will be effected. The proposed bill, according to Dr Loomis, is in effect a club wielded by the Union. He will keep this office informed as to developments, and when the boycott is called off, then CIE will be in a position to clear the bill.
