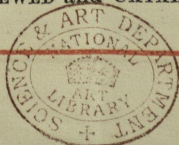

CONDITIONS OF SALE.

I. The highest Bidder to be the Buyer; and if any dispute shall arise between two or more Bidders, the Lot so disputed to be immediately put up again and re-sold.

II. No person to advance less than Sixpence; above Ten Shillings, One Shilling; above Five Pounds, Five Shillings; and so on in proportion.

III. The Purchasers to give in their names and places of abode, and pay down a deposit of twenty per cent. in part payment of the purchase-money; and in default of which, the Lot or Lots so purchased will be immediately put up again and re-sold. The remainder of the purchase-money to be paid on or before the 29th day of March, 1856, in Cash, or in Approved Bills, with Security (if required), as follows, that is to say;

The title will in all cases be the same as that under which the present proprietor holds the various Copyrights; but in the event of his being unable to satisfy the purchaser's objections or requirements with respect to the title of any work, the vendor shall have the power to annul the sale, and to return the deposit-money without interest or costs.

V. The lot or lots to be taken away, at the buyer's expense, within twenty-one days after the sale.

VI. The books are presumed to be perfect, unless otherwise expressed; but if upon collating any should prove defective, the Purchasers will be at liberty to take or reject them. Imperfections for the Quire Stock must be demanded within 28 days after the sale, or they cannot be supplied. If any variation in the number of books should occur through error in taking stock or otherwise, the amount shall be deducted from the purchase-money.

LASTLY. If the purchaser shall fail to comply with these Conditions, the deposit-money shall be forfeited to the vendor, and the contract for the same shall be void; and the vendor shall be at liberty to dispose of the Lot or Lots, either by public auction or private contract, as he may think fit, without any previous notice to the purchaser so neglecting or making default, and the deficiency (if any) arising from such second sale, shall be made good by the defaulter at this sale.
