1. The Liaison Office of the Osaka High Court has raised the question of citizenship status of Mr. Mamoru SAKATA, who is presently charged with embezzlement and theft. The case is now pending in the Gobo Branch of the Wakayama District Court.

2. Mr. Sakata was born in Seattle, Washington and at the time of registration with the Japanese consul, Japanese nationality was not reserved. However, prior to the late war, he returned to Japan and recovered Japanese citizenship 10 September 1949, upon his own application. The Wakayama court had proceeded upon the theory that Sakata is a Japanese national until he produces documentary evidence to the contrary, and when Mr. Sakata introduced his birth certificate, the court stopped proceedings until his citizenship could be determined.

3. This headquarters communicated by telephone with the American consul in Kobe. The Kobe office has no record of Mr. Sakata.

4. Request information as to the citizenship status of Mr. Sakata in order that we may advise the Osaka Court.

Cabinet Order for Temporary Measures concerning the Restriction on Sailing of those Persons having Permanent Domiciles in Nanseishoto south of 30° North Latitude

In accordance with the provision of the Ordinance relating to the Orders to be issued in Consequence of Acceptance of the Potsdam Declaration (Imperial Ordinance No. 542 of 1945), the Cabinet establishes this Cabinet Order.

(Restriction on sailing)

Article 1. Any person who has his permanent domicile in Nanseishoto south of 30° north latitude (including Kuchinoshima) shall not, for the time being, sail from outside the areas specified in the appended list to the areas specified in the said list without the approval of the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

(Penal provision)

Article 2. Any person who has violated the provision of the preceding Article shall be liable to penal servitude or imprisonment for not more than one year or a fine not exceeding 30,000 yen.

Article 3. The vessel used for the purpose of the commission of the offence prescribed in the preceding Article and owned or possessed by the offender shall be confiscated. In case any person other than the offender has acquired after the committal of the offence the vessel mentioned in the preceding paragraph the same shall apply unless the acquisition is deemed to have been made bona fide.

(Exception to the Code of Criminal Procedure)

Article 4. The provision of Article 15 of the Aliens Registration Ordinance (Imperial Ordinance No. 207 of 1947) shall apply mutatis mutandis in the case of offence prescribed in Article 2.

(Deportation)

Article 5. The Attorney-General may deport compulsorily any person who has committed the violation of the provision of Article 1.
2. The Attorney-General shall carry out the deportation mentioned in the preceding paragraph by making the governor of To, Do, Fu or prefecture issue the written deportation order.

(Execution of written deportation order)

Article 6. The written deportation order prescribed in the preceding Article shall be put into execution by the police official of the National Rural Police, the police official of Autonomous Entity Police, maritime safety official or other government or public official designated by the Attorney-General.

Supplementary Provisions:

1. This Cabinet Order shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.
2. As for the punishment of the person who did an act corresponding to the crime mentioned in Article 2 before the enforcement of this Cabinet Order, the provisions hitherto in force shall apply, provided that the penalty shall be fixed within the limits of the penalty prescribed in the said Article.
3. The Aliens Registration Ordinance shall be partially amended as follows:

In Article 16, " , as he stipulates," shall be deleted, and the following one paragraph shall be added to the said Article:

Compelling a person to leave Japan pursuant to the provisions of the preceding paragraph shall be carried out by making the governor of To, Do, Fu or prefecture issue the written deportation order in accordance with the provisions laid down by the Attorney-General.

In Article 17 paragraph 2, "In case the governor of To, Do, Fu or prefecture has compelled the person concerned to leave Japan under the preceding paragraph" shall be amended as "In case the governor of To, Do, Fu or prefecture has issued the written deportation order provided for in the preceding paragraph", and the following one paragraph shall be added next to paragraph 1 of the said Article:

Compelling a person to leave Japan under the provisions of the preceding paragraph shall be carried out by the governor of To, Do, Fu or prefecture by issuing the written deportation order.

The following one article shall be added next to Article 17:

Article 18. The written deportation order as provided for in the preceding two articles shall be executed by police officials of the National Rural Police, police officials of Autonomous Entity Police, the maritime safety officials, or other government or public officials designated by the Attorney-General.

1. The Liaison Office of the Osaka High Court has raised the question of citizenship status of Mr. Mamoru SAKATA, who is presently charged with embezzlement and theft. The case is now pending in the Gobo Branch of the Wakayama District Court.

2. Mr. Sakata was born in Seattle, Washington and at the time of registration with the Japanese consul, Japanese nationality was not reserved. However, prior to the late war, he returned to Japan and recovered Japanese citizenship 10 September 1949, upon his own application. The Wakayama court had proceeded upon the theory that Sakata is a Japanese national until he produces documentary evidence to the contrary, and when Mr. Sakata introduced his birth certificate, the court stopped proceedings until his citizenship could be determined.

3. This headquarters communicated by telephone with the American consul in Kobe. The Kobe office has no record of Mr. Sakata.

4. Request information as to the citizenship status of Mr. Sakata in order that we may advise the Osaka Court.

2. The directors of both institution state that applicants' conduct in prison have been excellent and warrant release. The directors feel that returning applicants to the Ryukyus to their guardian or family will aid in rehabilitating both inmates (Incls 1b and 2d). In the event the applications are approved, travel expenses will be paid by the respective prisons. (Incls 1c and 2e). *in file*

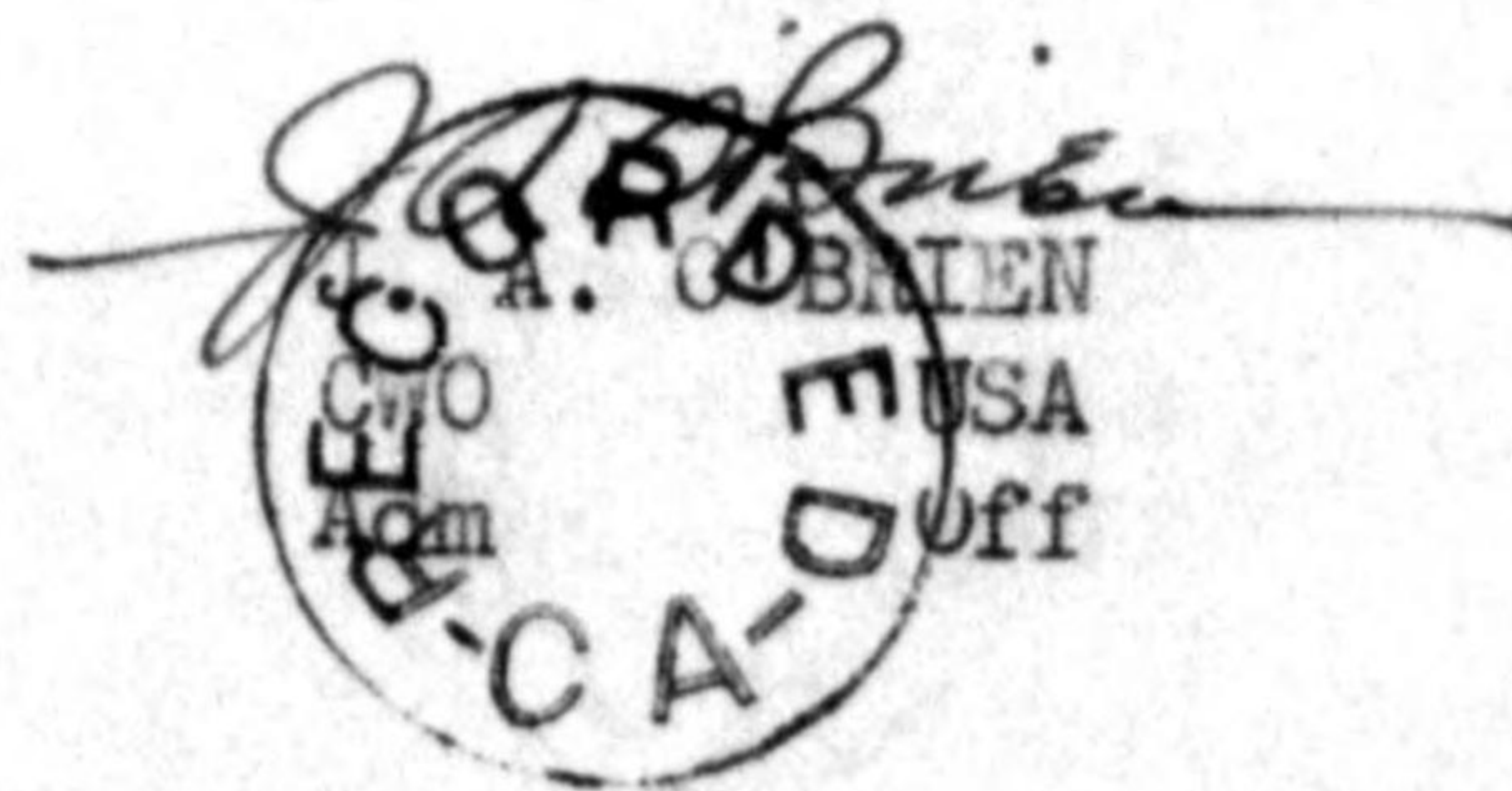

1. The Nara District Court submitted a question to the liaison office of the Osaka High Court, which in turn referred the matter to Civil Affairs region, regarding the nationality status of one Teruo SHIMIZU. Mr. Shimizu, who is currently being investigated by the Japanese authorities for having allegedly committed fraud, was born 30 July 1927, at Ukluelet, British Columbia, Canada. He was registered with the Japanese Consul in Vancouver on 2 August 1927. His permanent residence is Oaza-Kohama, Higashi-Tankaku-cho, Shingu-shi, Wakayama, and his present address is No. 63, Nakatsuji-cho, Nara-shi.

2. The suspect has not produced any papers to substantiate his Canadian nationality, and the court, prior to instituting judicial proceedings, is desirous of ascertaining whether he is entitled to the legal privileges of a UN national.

3. Request information in order that we may advise the court to proceed or to transfer the case to an occupation forces court.
