Mister Takeuchi is presently in Washington as representative of the newly established Japanese Government overseas agency. This brings to 12 the number of countries represented on the Tungsten-Molybdenum Committee. They are: Australia, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, France, The Federal Republic of Germany, Japan, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, The United Kingdom and The United States. Japan is also a member of the Cotton-Cotton Linters Committee and the Pulp-Paper Committee. Announcement of her membership in the International Materials Conference was made on Jun 17."

Para 1. Sixth session of contracting parties to GATT set meet at Geneva, Switzerland, commencing 17 Sep 51.

Para 2. In respect to ques United States posn concerning MFN trms for Japan, State Dept has prep fol recm posn paper for United States Trade Agreements Committee:

"Problem: Should any effort be made at the Sixth session of the contracting parties to obtain most-favored nation treatment for Japan?"

"Recommendation: The question should not be placed on the sixth session agenda."

"Discussion: During the drafting of the ITO Charter and the GATT in 1947 and attempt to have the occupied areas included meet with strong opposition. The United States delegation succeeded in having a final note included in the GATT reserving study of the matter, with the expectation that the occupied areas question would be resolved at the Havana conference which completed the drafting of the proposed ITO Charter. However, it was not resolved at that conference, although the door was 'kept open' by amending Article 71 of the proposed ITO Charter to provide that 'The conference, on application by the competent authorities, shall determine the conditions upon which rights and obligations under this charter shall apply to such authorities in respect of territories under military occupation and shall determine the extent of such rights and obligations.'

"At the second session of the contracting parties in August of 1948 an effort was made to negotiate a protocol which would commit the signatories to apply to the merchandise of any of the occupied

areas the provisions of GATT relating to most-favored-nation treatment - to the extent that such area accorded reciprocal Most-Favored-Nation treatment to the signatory in question. However, the United States delegation was successful in negotiating a Most-Favored-Nation agreement for Western Germany only.

" Since the United Kingdom and the Dominions appeared to be the major obstacle to an agreement for Japan, a conference was held in London in November 1948, attended by representatives of the United States, and the United Kingdom and its Dominions, to try to work out a coordinated position for securing a Most-Favored-Nation agreement at the third session of the contracting parties. After the London conference continuing action was taken by the State Department through the embassies in the respective capitals to secure concurrence to the principle of Most-Favored-Nation treatment for Japan at the third session and a meeting was held with the Canadians in March 1949, to determine the type of agreement they might accept.

"Immediately after the opening of the third session at Annecy in April 1949, the United Kingdom informed the United States Embassy in London that it could not consider a Most-Favored-Nation agreement for Japan until after the establishment of an exchange rate and after sufficient time had elapsed to observe the operation of that exchange rate, perhaps a year. Discussions by the embassies in the Hague and Brussels in March and April indicated the Benelux Countries would oppose at Annecy the proposed agreement and there was no assurance France would support the United States on this matter. In conversations in Annecy, some other countries, including a few of the key trading countries of the world, were opposed to raising the Japanese matter. It became apparent that any working party which might be set up to consider an agreement for Japan would not be likely to report favorably. Also, there was continuing pressure to complete action on the agenda by the end of May. Since there did not appear to be any likelihood of obtaining the agreement of the contracting parties to Most-Favored-Nation treatment for Japan the matter was withdrawn from the agenda, at which time the Chairman of the United States delegation made a statement indicating the United States would continue to urge strongly governments to make desired assurances of Most-Favored-Nation treatment for Japan.

"After the item was withdrawn from the agenda diplomatic efforts were made in London, the Hague, Brussels and Paris, by State, Army and SCAP Representatives to obtain a commitment from the United Kingdom, Belgium, the Netherlands and France.

"At the end of the third session an effort was made to obtain a recommendation from working party 10 that Japan, Western Germany and Korea be included in the list of countries invited to participate in the third-round negotiations to commence in September 1950. A

special meeting of the working party was convened in September 1949 at London to consider among other things invitations to those 3 countries. The working party decided to recommend that invitations be sent to Western Germany and Korea, but Norway was the only country which voted with the United States to invite Japan.

"It was believed inadvisable to take any formal action at the fourth session with respect to Japan. However, the United States delegate suggested the possibility of raising the question at the fifth session and was hopeful that other contracting parties would join in working out a method to arrive at this end. The State Department induced the Embassy at London on October 19, 1950 (A-568 London) to seek the cooperation of the British along certain lines designed to obtain economic and political stability in Japan, including British acceptance of an agreement covering most-favored-nation treatment for Japan on a reciprocal basis, and eventual support of Japanese admission to GATT. It was requested that the United States and United Kingdom delegations at Torquay be instructed to discuss the technical details of a most-favored-nation agreement. The Embassy was unsuccessful in obtaining the support of the British Government. The matter was also discussed with a number of delegations at Torquay. Only one government indicated clearly that it would support the United States if the question of such an agreement were formally raised. As a result, the item, which had been placed on the preliminary agenda of the fifth session of the contracting parties by the secretariat, was withdrawn.

"It would not appear desirable or feasible at the present time to take any step through the contracting parties to obtain most-favored-nation treatment for Japan. In view of the expected early signature of a treaty of peace, it would not be appropriate to negotiate an arrangement such as the agreement with Germany. The 'Agreement on most-favored-nation treatment for areas of western Germany under military occupation' provides that it shall be effective 'for such time as any signatory of this agreement participates in the occupation or control of any area in Western Germany'. When a treaty is signed treaties of friendship, commerce and navigation, and other commercial instruments of a type normally negotiated by sovereign governments should be negotiated between Japan and other

Believed fund proposal acceptable and in order avoid possible protracted delays in attempting to secure agreement other agencies and IMF Staff to modify below statements to correspond more closely with URMSG, recm your concurrence. Complete text fund proposal folg:

"The Supreme Commander hereby states that the Japanese Govt is authorized to apply for membership in the IMF, and if offered membership, to accept the articles of agreement and all the terms prescribed in the membership resolution. The Japanese Govt is also authorized to take all the steps nec to enable it to carry out all its obligations under the articles of agreement and the membership resolution. the assumption of such obligations by the Japanese Govt, but also heartily endorses and is fully sympathetic with the aspirations of the Japanese people and Govt to participate in the IMF. The obligations to be assumed by the Japanese Govt include, according to present practice, the obligation that in the period between accepting membership and agreeing on an initial par value, Japan will not change its exchange rates prevailing at the time of accepting membership without prior approval of the fund.

"It is the duty of the SCAP to maintain gen surveillance over the activities of the Japanese Govt until a treaty of peace becomes effective. It is, therefore, to be understood that SCAPs auth remains unimpaired. However, that auth will not be exercised in such way as to hamper the Japanese Govt in fulfilling its functions in and obligations to the IMF."

3. In view prev discussions Jap ofls with fund, assume familiar with procedure for appl. After formal appls usual procedure is for Exec Board of Fund submit matter to Membership Committee which, in consultation applicant determines quota, gold contribution and other conditions and terms membership. So called "Bretton Woods Formula" while of no official significance quota computation, frequently used as point of departure. For your info elements this formula as follows:

- a. 2% national income 1940.
- b. 10% annual imports 1934-38.
- c. 10% maximum variation annual exports 1934-38.
- d. 5% gold and dollar holdings 1940.
- e. Sum a through d increased by percentage equal to ratio of annual average exports 34-38 to 1940 national income.
- f. 90% of e which is quota.

4. Gold contribution set forth Article 3, Sec 3, Fund Agreement probably will be 10% of net ofl holdings gold and US dollars. In view of complex aspects these computations and interpretations fund board likely to be involved, any discussions with Japs you deem nec should be confined gen principles. Interested NAC Agencies and DEPTER here now involved consideration of aprop quota and gold contribution to Japan as basis NAC instruction US exec dir fund. NAC Staff room will be sent for your comments before final action.
