MEMORANDUM

1 October 1949SECURITY INSPECTIONS

1. Effective 1 October 1949, the Commanding Officer of TIS will designate daily a team consisting of one (1) officer and two (2) enlisted men of the first 3 grades to conduct security inspections of the NYK Building.
2. Inspections will begin one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) hour after close of duty hours and will include all offices on the first, second, third, fourth and fifth floors. The detail will base its actions on Ar 380-5. The inspection will include violations such as open safes and cabinets, unsecured classified and classified waste material, unlocked doors, open windows, lights and fans left on, radiators not turned off, etc.
3. In the case of open safes and cabinets containing classified matters, the security inspection officer will call the appropriate section's executive officer and request that an inventory be made immediately to determine whether any classified matter has been compromised. In the event no inventory is made within one (1) hour of the time of the notice, the Officer of the Day will call the CO, TIS and inform him of the circumstances. The case, cabinets, or safe will be closed and locked in the meantime. In the event it cannot be locked, it will be placed under physical guard. In the event classified matter is found and cannot be placed under lock and key, it will be put in an envelope with the Room No. on it and turned over to the TIS OD for return to proper section the following duty day. TIS OD will secure such data in accordance with provisions of 380-5 or will keep the material on his person.
4. Security inspection officer will submit report on attached form and turn in to TIS Officer of the Day and will be relieved by OD prior to leaving the NYK Building. In turn, he will relieve his enlisted detail. In no case will this relief be prior to two (2) hours after the official close of business. The intent of this provision is to indicate that the required time to perform this duty in thorough manner requires a minimum of one and one-half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) hours. The exact time of this relief will be entered in the Guard Book.
5. The Officer of the Day will turn the report in to TIS Adjutant when reporting for relief from tour of duty.
6. Executive officers to be called in compliance with par. 3 are, CI Div, MIS Div, Public Safety Div, TIS, G-2 Historical Sec, Geographic, and Targets.

7. TIS Adjutant will maintain a roster for the Security Officer and CO, Troop Detachment will maintain enlisted roster.

8. The Security Inspecting Officer will report to TIS Adjutant for instructions one-half (½) hour before the close of duty each day.

1. Reference is made to memorandum to the Japanese Government, file AG 386.6 (24 Sept 47)CPC/FP, SCAPIN 1783, subject, "Safeguarding Property Stored in Looted Property Warehouses in Japan" from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

2. Request is made that sufficient trained and armed Japanese police be assigned to the CPC warehouses at Setagaya to provide three (3) guards on a twenty four (24) hours basis.

3. Justifications for above request are as follows:

a. The Civil Property Custodian has property of high value, both looted and former German owned, stored in these warehouses.

b. Responsibility for custody by 8th Army has been rescinded and present Military Guards will be withdrawn at the earliest possible date and in any event not later than 15 November 1949.

c. The responsibilities of CPC through SCAP to higher authority and the value and nature of the properties make it mandatory that proper security be maintained by armed and properly trained personnel; hence the use of unarmed, civilian guards is not considered feasible.

3. Requested personnel should be assigned prior to 10 October 1949 to facilitate familiarization with the Setagaya compound activities prior to withdrawal of military personnel, estimated 15 November 1949.

1. The Metropolitan Police Department will furnish three (3) armed guards on a 24-hour basis for the CPC warehouses at Setagaya.

2. Inspector Harada, MFD, will report to Captain Haber at the CPC warehouse on 3 October 1949 for instructions and will arrange to have policemen on duty prior to 10 October 1949.

3. It is desired that PSD/G-2 be notified when the contents of these warehouses no longer require special guards so that Japanese police may be reverted to normal police functions.

DUTIES OF TIS GUARD PERSONNEL

(Reference: FM 26-5)

SECTION I - General Information to all Members
of the Guard.

SECTION II - Duties of the Guard.

SECTION I - General Information to all Members of the Guard.

1. Japanese Nationals are not allowed in the quarters of allied personnel except on official business. Any Japanese National apprehended in such quarters, not on official business, will be placed under arrest and brought to the Sergeant of the Guard for questioning. The names of all personnel in the room at the time of the incident will be taken and a complete report made in the Informal Incident Report Book.

2. No female personnel will be allowed in the quarters of allied male personnel at any time (except Japanese maids in the performance of their duties on the 7th Floor from 0800 to 1630 hours daily).

a. When female personnel (other than Japanese maids performing their authorized duties) are found in the quarters of male personnel, the names of all persons present will be reported to the Sergeant of the Guard. A complete report of the circumstances will be made in the Informal Incident Report Book.

3. The Japanese Guard in the rear area of the NYK Building will telephone the guard office (26-7541, Ext 62) at half-hour intervals reporting "all clear" or details of any incident occurring in the vicinity of his post. The Corporal whose relief is on post will make an appropriate entry in the guard incident book.

4. The southwest basement entrance of the NYK Building is designated as a service entrance only. No personnel will be permitted to enter or leave the building by this entrance except those assisting in hauling supplies or equipment or in the disposal of trash and garbage.

5. Within the NYK Building, the Guard will arrest all suspicious looking persons, disturbers of the peace, and persons taken in the act of committing a crime against the U. S. Government. Persons arrested by the guard will be conducted at once to the Sergeant of the Guard by the Corporal of the relief on post.

6. The Incident Report Book will be maintained by the Sergeant and Corporals of the Guard and will cover the following:

a. Inspections by OD and Officer of the Guard and Sergeant of the Guard.

a. When female personnel (other than Japanese personnel performing authorized duties) are found in the quarters of male personnel, the names of all persons present will be reported to the Sergeant of the Guard. A complete report of the circumstances will be made in the Informal Incident Report Book.

3. The Japanese Guard in the rear area of the NYK Building will telephone the guard office (26-7541, Ext 62) at half-hour intervals reporting "all clear" or details of any incident occurring in the vicinity of his post. The Corporal whose relief is on post will make an appropriate entry in the guard incident book.

4. The southwest basement entrance of the NYK Building is designated as a service entrance only. No personnel will be permitted to enter or leave the building by this entrance except those assisting in hauling supplies or equipment or in the disposal of trash and garbage.

5. Within the NYK Building, the Guard will arrest all suspicious looking persons, disturbers of the peace, and persons taken in the act of committing a crime against the U. S. Government. Persons arrested by the guard will be conducted at once to the Sergeant of the Guard by the Corporal of the relief on post.

6. The Incident Report Book will be maintained by the Sergeant and Corporals of the Guard and will cover the following:

- a. Inspections by OD and Officer of the Guard and Sergeant of the Guard.
 - b. All routine incidents pertaining to the guard.
 - c. Incidents of serious nature i.e. arrest of personnel, robberies, etc.
- These will also be reported by OD in written report to CO, TIS.

SECTION II - Duties of the Guard.

7. Officer of the Day.

a. The Officer of the Day is the personal representative of TIS Commanding Officer and is charged with the responsibility of maintaining security, and proper order and decorum within the NYK Building.

b. The OD will have general supervision over the Officer of the Guard and all enlisted members of the guard. He will be familiar with all their orders and duties.

c. The OD will be governed during his tour of duty by provisions of TIS Staff Memorandum No. 40-4, dated 7 January 1949 and FM 25-5.

d. The OD will make two complete inspections, one before midnight and one between midnight and daylight, of the NYK Building to include the following:

- (1) Exterior of the NYK Building to include the Motor Pool and Japanese exterior guards. Will inspect motor sheds, dispatch building and all motor vehicles for unauthorized persons.
- (2) The first floor and basement including all doors and hallways. Special attention will be paid to Rooms 2E and 3E to insure that windows and doors are locked when these rooms are not in use. Sections responsible for these two rooms will notify the OD when they are to be used.
- (3) Spot check the 5th, 6th and 7th floor billets for violations of TIS Billeting Regulations.
- (4) The roof.
- (5) Insure that all gates in rear of NYK Building are locked as of 1730, excepting on Wednesdays and Saturdays when they will be locked at 1300. These gates will remain locked on Sundays and holidays.
- (6) Spot check Japanese quarters and wash rooms at night for evidence of illegal traffic or use of government property.

e. At 1800 on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday and 1230 on Wednesday and Saturday will move the guard office to the information desk. The information desk will be supervised by the OD, OG, or Sergeant of the Guard to prevent unauthorized traffic in or out, and unauthorized visitors from entering the building.

f. There is an extension from Director, MIS Div's outside telephone, (26-5368) located in the guard room. This extension will be turned "on" during non-office hours and monitored by the guard who will answer all calls if not answered by Director's office. The OD will insure that guard understands and complies with these instructions.

g. Deleted per IOM MIS Div to ATIS dated 6 June 49.

h. The old and new Officers of the Day will report to the Adjutant, TIS, at 1100 daily for instructions. The old OD will bring the Guard Book and the Incident Report Book at time of reporting.

(5) Insure that gates of 1730, excepting on Wednesdays and Saturdays when they will be locked at 1300. These gates will remain locked on Sundays and holidays.

(6) Spot check Japanese quarters and wash rooms at night for evidence of illegal traffic or use of government property.

e. At 1800 on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday and 1230 on Wednesday and Saturday will move the guard office to the information desk. The information desk will be supervised by the OD, OG, or Sergeant of the Guard to prevent unauthorized traffic in or out, and unauthorized visitors from entering the building.

f. There is an extension from Director, MIS Div's outside telephone, (26-5368) located in the guard room. This extension will be turned "on" during non-office hours and monitored by the guard who will answer all calls if not answered by Director's office. The OD will insure that guard understands and complies with these instructions.

g. Deleted per IOM MIS Div to ATIS dated 6 June 49.

h. The old and new Officers of the Day will report to the Adjutant, TIS, at 1100 daily for instructions. The old OD will bring the Guard Book and the Incident Report Book at time of reporting.

8. Officer of the Guard. (G-2 Interpreter on Call)

a. The G-2 Interpreter on Call upon his release by G-2 will immediately report to the Officer of the Day and assume the duties of Officer of the Guard.

b. The OG will assist the OD in the supervision of the guard personnel in addition to his duties as set forth in TIS Staff Memorandum No. 40-4, dated 7 January 1949.

c. The OG will make the same inspections as the OD at times specified by the OD.

9. Sergeant of the Guard.

a. The senior non-commissioned officer of the guard, will be the Sergeant of the Guard.

b. The Sergeant of the Guard will have general supervision over the other

non-commissioned officers and privates of the guard. He will be familiar with all of their orders and duties.

c. He is responsible to the Officer of the Day for the guard property.

d. He will assign the corporals and privates of the guard to reliefs and will furnish the Officer of the Guard with a list showing the name and post of duty of each member of the guard.

e. He will see that all reliefs are turned out at the proper time and that the corporals thoroughly understand, and are prompt and efficient in, the discharge of their duties.

f. The Sergeant of the Guard will spot check Japanese quarters and wash rooms at night for evidence of illegal traffic or use of government property.

g. The Sergeant of the Guard will make three (3) checks to see that all office doors on the first, second, third, and fourth floors are locked. Any doors found unlocked will be locked and an entry made in the Informal Incident Report Book.

h. He will inspect the guard at least once before midnight and once between midnight and daylight at hours specified by the OD. These inspections will include the motor pool, dispatch office and the exterior Japanese guard.

i. During the temporary absence from the guardroom of the Sergeant of the Guard, the Corporal of the Guard whose relief is on post will assume his duties.

j. Should the corporal whose relief is on post be called away from the guardroom, the Sergeant of the Guard will temporarily take his place or designate another non-commissioned officer of the guard to do so.

k. The Sergeant of the Guard will maintain the Guard Report Book (WD AGO Form #10) and the Informal Incident Report Book.

l. He will report to the Officer of the Day any suspicious or unusual occurrence that comes to his attention and notify him of all persons arrested by the guard.

m. The Sergeant of the Guard will take direct charge of prisoners and arrange for their disposition with the Officer of the Day.

n. He will keep the building keys in his personal possession while at the guardroom. Should he leave the guardroom for any purpose he will turn the keys over to the corporal of the guard who takes his place. Keys will be loaned

h. He will inspect the guard at least once before midnight and once between midnight and daylight at hours specified by the OD. These inspections will include the motor pool, dispatch office and the exterior Japanese guard.

i. During the temporary absence from the guardroom of the Sergeant of the Guard, the Corporal of the Guard whose relief is on post will assume his duties.

l. He will report to the Officer of the Day any suspicious or unusual occurrence that comes to his attention and notify him of all persons arrested by the guard.

m. The Sergeant of the Guard will take direct charge of prisoners and arrange for their disposition with the Officer of the Day.

n. He will keep the building keys in his personal possession while at the guardroom. Should he leave the guardroom for any purpose he will turn the keys over to the corporal of the guard who takes his place. Keys will be loaned to no one other than Utilities Officer except by order from the Officer of the Day, the CO, TIS, or the Commander, Troop Detachment. When a room is opened by the guard, the person for whom the room is opened will properly identify himself and the incident recorded in the Informal Incident Report Book.

o. The Sergeant of the Guard forms the guard whenever a formation is necessary.

p. The Sergeant of the Guard is responsible for the proper police of the guardroom.

q. In case of fire the Sergeant of the Guard will send an off duty sentry to open Fire exit K (west entrance to NYK Building). This sentry will then direct personnel out of the building, maintaining order, preventing panic and insuring rapid, orderly evacuation of the building.

10. Corporal of the Guard.

a. The Corporal of the Guard receives and obeys orders only from the Commanding Officer, Officer of the Day, Officer of the Guard, and Sergeant of the Guard.

b. Each Corporal of the Guard will assign the members of his relief to posts by number. Such assignment will not be changed except by permission of the Officer of the Day. He will prepare duplicate lists of his reliefs showing: the relief number, name and post number of each member of his relief. One copy of this list will be furnished to the Sergeant of the Guard.

c. It is the duty of each corporal of the guard to instruct the members of his relief regarding their orders and duties. Each corporal will thoroughly acquaint himself with the special orders of every sentinel of his relief and see that each understands such orders.

d. He will immediately report to the Sergeant of the Guard any violation of regulations or any unusual occurrence which is reported to him by a sentinel or which comes to his attention.

e. There will be at least one non-commissioned officer of the guard constantly on the alert at the guardroom, normally the corporal whose relief is on post. This non-commissioned officer will take post near the entrance of the guardroom and will not fall in with the guard when it is formed. He will have his rifle or other prescribed arm constantly with him. Whenever it becomes necessary for the corporal to leave his post at the guardroom, he will notify the Sergeant of the Guard, who will at once take his place or designate another non-commissioned officer of the guard to do so. He will see that no person enters the guardroom without authority.

f. Should the guard be turned out, each corporal will call his own relief and cause its members to fall in promptly.

g. He will wake the corporal whose relief is next on post in time for the latter to verify the prisoners, form his relief, and post it at the proper hour.

h. He will inspect his relief at least once every hour and will include in his inspection the motor pool, dispatch office, and exterior Japanese guard.

i. The corporal of the guard, whose relief is on post, will make certain the three (3) gates between the NYK building and the ATIS Motor Pool are unlocked at 0700 and locked at 1730 daily.

j. During the inspection of his relief the corporal of the guard will check the Security of basement doors, 18 and 19.

k. The corporal whose relief is on post will make frequent inspections of the fire escapes. Any person found on the fire escapes will be turned over to the Sergeant of the Guard for questioning.

k. The corporal whose relief is on post will make frequent inspections of the fire escapes. Any person found on the fire escapes will be turned over to the Sergeant of the Guard for questioning.

l. He will make spot checks in Japanese quarters and in wash rooms at night for evidence of illegal traffic or use of government property.

11. Privates of the Guard.

a. Privates are assigned to reliefs by the sergeant of the guard and to posts by the corporal of their relief. Privates are not changed from one relief to another except by proper authority.

b. Privates of the guard will be familiar with the general orders for sentinels and with special orders applying to their particular posts. A copy of special orders for each post will be available in the guardroom and another copy will be posted at each guard post.

c. Guards will make close check for uniform violations and report all violations to the sergeant of the guard. The wearing of moccasins, improper head-dress and unauthorized jackets or coats constitute the most common violations.

d. Guards will challenge all persons, regardless of status or rank, who attempt to enter the NYK building after 2400 hours. Each person must show proper identification and authorization or reasonable cause to be in the building at this time. In case proper identification is not produced, or there is doubt

as to the validity of the cause for entrance, the person will be held and the Corporal of the Guard called at once.

e. Guards will stand at attention when approached by an officer and if posted outside the buildings, will salute all officers.

f. After relief, each member not at once required for duty will place his arm in the arm rack or stack and will not remove it therefrom unless required in the performance of some duty.

SPECIAL ORDERS FOR SUPERNUMERARY OF THE GUARD

1. My post is located in the Guardroom except when I am on duty at the Information Desk in the main lobby or as otherwise directed by the Officer of the Day, Officer of the Guard or Sergeant of the Guard.

2. I will be familiar with the Fire Regulations for the NYK Building and with General and Special Orders for the Guard.

3. I will relieve sentinels on post as directed by the Sergeant of the Guard.

SPECIAL ORDERS FOR GUARD POST-#1

1. My post is Number 1. It is located at the North (Main) entrance to the NYK Building just inside the center door. It is a 24-hour, standing post.

2. I will familiarize myself with the Fire Regulations for the NYK Building; these regulations are posted on this post.

3. I will become familiar with the location of all fire fighting equipment on or near this post and allow no one to tamper with this equipment, except in case of fire.

4. In case of fire, I will:

a. Call TIS telephone operator and give location and extent of fire; telephone is located at the Information Desk.

b. Call the Corporal of the Guard and request necessary help to control traffic at the main entrance.

c. Open all three (3) doors at main entrance.

d. Remain at my post, maintaining order, preventing panic and insuring rapid, orderly evacuation of the building.

SPECIAL ORDERS FOR GUARD POST-#1

1. My post is Number 1. It is located at the North (Main) entrance to the NYK Building just inside the center door. It is a 24-hour, standing post.
2. I will familiarize myself with the Fire Regulations for the NYK Building; these regulations are posted on this post.
3. I will become familiar with the location of all fire fighting equipment on or near this post and allow no one to tamper with this equipment, except in case of fire.
4. In case of fire, I will:
 - a. Call TIS telephone operator and give location and extent of fire; telephone is located at the Information Desk.
 - b. Call the Corporal of the Guard and request necessary help to control traffic at the main entrance.
 - c. Open all three (3) doors at main entrance.
 - d. Remain at my post, maintaining order, preventing panic and insuring rapid, orderly evacuation of the building.
5. I will allow no loitering in the lobby or on the steps by the door, and will maintain order and control traffic at all times.
6. I will require all Department of the Army Civilians, Japanese and Foreign Nationals to present an AGO Identification Card, a Provost Marshal Identification or TIS Civilian Personnel Pass upon entering the NYK Building. Individuals who do not possess one of the above, I will refer to the Information Desk where they may receive a visitor pass; I will insure that these persons do not by-pass the Information Desk.
7. I will require DAC's and Japanese and Foreign Nationals to show their passes as they leave the building. I will pick up all visitor passes as visitors leave the building. I will turn in these passes to the Information Desk upon being relieved.
8. I will search all Japanese Nationals leaving the building who are suspected of having American goods in their possession. I will confiscate all such articles, place the holder under arrest and call the Corporal of the Guard.

9. I will require all EM who leave the building after work hours to show their Class A pass prior to departing.

10. I will enforce uniform regulations and allow no enlisted personnel who are not in proper uniform to leave the building. I will report all violations to the Corporal of the Guard, giving name, rank, serial number, and organization of the offender.

11. Curfew is 2400 hours. I will report to the Corporal of my relief all cases of violation of curfew.

12. I will require all persons regardless of status or rank, who seek entrance to the NYK Building after 2400 hours, to present proper identification. In case such identification is not produced, I will hold the individual at my post and call the Corporal of the Guard.

13. I will allow no vehicles to park in the NO PARKING area in front of the building.

14. I will allow no EM, DAC, JN or FN to take Government property and equipment from NYK Building unless authorized in writing by Director, MIS Div, CO, TIS, Chief, PSD, Chief, Historical Section or Chief, Compilations Branch, CIS.

SPECIAL ORDERS FOR GUARD POST NO. 3

1. My post is No. 3. My post is a continual roving post covering an area generally around the NYK Building and Motor Pool. The hours for this post are from 1700 to 0800 daily. (Diagram attached)

2. I will familiarize myself with the Fire Regulations for the NYK Building.

3. I will become familiarized with the location of all fire fighting equipment on or near this post and allow no one to tamper with this equipment except in case of fire.

4. In case of fire I will:

a. Call TIS telephone operator and give location and extent of fire. Telephones are located in the motor pool dispatchers office or at the Information Desk.

b. Call Corporal of the Guard and request necessary help to control traffic.

c. Remain at my post maintaining order and security of government property.

SPECIAL ORDERS FOR GUARD POST NO. 3

1. My post is No. 3. My post is a continual roving post covering an area generally around the NYK Building and Motor Pool. The hours for this post are from 1700 to 0800 daily. (Diagram attached)
2. I will familiarize myself with the Fire Regulations for the NYK Building.
3. I will become familiarized with the location of all fire fighting equipment on or near this post and allow no one to tamper with this equipment except in case of fire.
4. In case of fire I will:
 - a. Call TIS telephone operator and give location and extent of fire. Telephones are located in the motor pool dispatchers office or at the Information Desk.
 - b. Call Corporal of the Guard and request necessary help to control traffic.
 - c. Remain at my post maintaining order and security of government property.
5. I will enforce uniform regulations and military courtesy.
6. I will allow no vehicle to park in NO PARKING area in front of the building.
7. I will not allow any articles to be taken from the building through windows or unauthorized exits.
8. I will be particularly watchful in the motor pool and will inspect motor sheds, dispatch office, and all motor vehicles for unauthorized persons and activities.
9. I will inspect the area between the motor pool and NYK building for unauthorized persons and activities.

SPECIAL ORDERS FOR GUARD POST #4

1. My Post is Number 4. It is located at rear (south central) basement

entrance to the NYK Building. It is a 24-hour, standing post.

2. I will become familiar with the Fire Regulations for the NYK Building; these regulations are posted on this post.

3. I will familiarize myself with the location of all fire fighting equipment on or near this post and allow no one to tamper with this equipment except in case of fire.

4. In case of fire, I will:

a. Call TIS Telephone Operator and give the location and extent of the fire.

b. Call the Guard Room (Extension 62) and give the locations and extent of the fire.

c. Remain at my post maintaining order, preventing panic and insuring rapid, orderly evacuation of the building.

5. I will permit no loitering in the hallway or at the doorway and will maintain order and control traffic at all times. I will report all violations of regulations to the Corporal of the Guard, giving full identification of the offender and details of the offense.

6. I will not permit military or DAC personnel to enter or leave the building by this entrance unless required in the performance of their duties.

7. I will supervise the search of all Japanese by the Japanese Guards for rations or government property of any kind, including PX items. I will confiscate all such articles, place holder under arrest and call the Corporal of the Guard.

8. I will supervise the issuance of guest badges to Japanese visitors to the Utilities Office or Japanese Manager's Office.

9. I will direct all other visitors to the main (North) entrance. I will make certain that duties of the Japanese guards are properly carried out.

10. I will cooperate with the Utilities, Supply and PX Officers as requested in matters regarding control of supervision of Japanese employees near my post.

11. Curfew is 2400 hours. I will refer all persons regardless of status or rank who seek entrance or exit to the NYK Building after 2400 hours, to the main (North) entrance.

12. The draw-bridges on both fire escapes are equipped with a bell that rings

12. The draw-bridges on both fire escapes are equipped with a bell that rings when the draw-bridge is lowered. The bridge will be kept up at all times except in case of fire or fire drills. If the bell rings, indicating someone is trespassing on the fire escapes, I will immediately place the trespasser under arrest and call the Corporal of the Guard.

13. I will allow no EM, DAC JN or FN to take Government property and equipment from NYK Building unless authorized in writing by Director, MIS Div, CO, TIS, Chief, PSD, Chief, Historical Section or Chief, Compilations Branch, CIS.

SPECIAL ORDERS FOR GUARD POST #5

1. My Post is Number 5. It is located at the rear (southwest) basement entrance to the NYK Building during the hours 0800 to 1700 on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday; 0800 to 1300 on Wednesday and Saturday. During all other hours including all day Sunday and holidays my post covers the basement and first floor as indicated on these floor plans (Note. A Copy of the basement and first floor plans will be posted in the guard room and on Post No. 5 giving route to be followed by the sentinel while the post is a roving one.)

2. I will become familiar with the Fire Regulations for the NYK Building; these regulations are posted on this post.

3. I will familiarize myself with the location of all fire fighting equipment on or near this post and allow no one to tamper with this equipment except in case of fire.

4. In case of fire, I will:

a. Call TIS Telephone Operator and give the location and extent of the fire.

b. Call the Guard Room (Extension 62) and give the location and extent of the fire.

c. I will open the rear (southwest) basement door if it is locked and remain posted there, maintaining order, preventing panic and insuring rapid, orderly evacuation of the building.

5. I will permit no personnel to enter or leave the building through the entrance at my post except those on required work details conducted in the immediate rear of the building. I will check these personnel for proper identification as they leave and again as they return.

6. I will direct all Japanese who wish to visit the Japanese Building Manager on business matters to the south center rear (Japanese employee's) entrance. I will direct all other personnel to the main (north) entrance.

7. I will closely observe all Japanese workers for government property or rations of any kind, including PX items; I will confiscate all such articles, place the holder under arrest and call the Corporal of the Guard.

8. I will supervise the orderly removal of trash and garbage brought to the basement by the freight elevator near my post. (This refuse will not be permitted to remain in the hallway but will be moved immediately to the rack outside the building.)

9. I will cooperate with the Utilities, Supply, and PX officers as requested in matters regarding control or supervision of Japanese employees near my post.

10. I will supervise all outgoing services functions at my post. (Example: removal of laundry, supplies etc.) checking to prevent smuggling of anything out of NYK Building.

11. I will enforce all regulations and report violation of same to the Corporal of the Guard, giving full identity of the offender and the nature of the offense.

I will be especially watchful for fires.

6. I will direct all Japanese who wish to come on business matters to the south center rear (Japanese employee's) entrance. I will direct all other personnel to the main (north) entrance.

7. I will closely observe all Japanese workers for government property or rations of any kind, including PX items; I will confiscate all such articles, place the holder under arrest and call the Corporal of the Guard.

8. I will supervise the orderly removal of trash and garbage brought to the basement by the freight elevator near my post. (This refuse will not be permitted to remain in the hallway but will be moved immediately to the rack outside the building.)

9. I will cooperate with the Utilities, Supply, and PX officers as requested in matters regarding control or supervision of Japanese employees near my post.

10. I will supervise all outgoing services functions at my post. (Example: removal of laundry, supplies etc.) checking to prevent smuggling of anything out of NYK Building.

11. I will enforce all regulations and report violation of same to the Corporal of the Guard, giving full identity of the offender and the nature of the offense.

12. During my tour as roving guard I will be especially watchful for fires, unauthorized persons, unlocked doors and windows in the following offices and storerooms:

- a. Room 100 (all doors leading from main lobby).
- b. Room 101 (all doors leading from main lobby).
- c. All rooms and storerooms in basement.
- d. Rooms 1W, 2W, 3W and 4W.
- e. Rooms 1E, 2E and 4E.

13. I will allow no EM, DAC, JN or FN to take Government property and equipment from NYK Building unless authorized in writing by Director, MIS Div, CO, TIS, Chief, PSD, Chief, Historical Section or Chief, Compilations Branch, CIS.
