Convention Paragraphs.

The twenty-third annual convention of the American Association of Nurserymen was held in Omaha June 8th to 9th.

Every State in the Union is now represented by the roll of names of members, which numbers 426. There was a full representation of the members who usually attend these meetings, to which were added many Western nurserymen who had heretofore not been present at these conventions.

Evidence was brought from all sections of the country of an era of returning prosperity. Not since 1893 has the business tone amongst nurserymen been so hopeful and buoyant. A uniform belief was expressed that better prices will be obtained for nursery products the coming year, and a sufficient number of sales were wore made at advanced prices to establish this conviction.

The next convention will be held in Chicago in June, 1899.

Exposition influences were brought to bear in the selection of Omaha as the place of this meeting, and all were rejoiced with the opportunity of witnessing this wonderful creation. The Trans-Mississippi Exposition is magnificent in conception and accomplishment, exceeding in artistic beauty and practical demonstration of the rich products of the great North West anything of the kind attempted since the World's Fair.

Quarantining Plants.

The Canadian Government has prohibited absolutely the introduction of certain nursery stock from the United States to the Dominion, for fear of introducing the San Jose Scale. Americans cannot much complain, as most of the States have been quarantining each other: and Germany, alarmed by our own excitement. has prohibited American fruits. To show how silly this is, it is only necessary to say that the insect already exists in most of these places, and, if not, can easily get there in a multitude of ways aside from traveling by nursery stock. The Colorado potato beetle simply took a ride on a railroad train for the East; and the Scale can get across the line on a bird's foot or feather just as well as on a tree, and no doubt can breed just as well on a native forest tree as on any tree from a nursery. Puck says: "What fools these mortals be."-Meehan's Monthly.

Raffia For Budding, Grafting and Tying.

On every private place of any pretension as to size there is more or less grafting and budding to be done. Various materials are in use for tying in the grafts or buds, but none are the equal of Raffia. It is broad, soft and pliable, and does not bind the bark as readily as others. Bass bark was once the popular material for these purposes, but it was less convenient, requiring wetting at the time of using. Raffia is procured in long plaits, the strands of which are cut up into desired lengths. It is the product of the leaves of a palm, "Raffia pedunculata," which grows only in Madagascar. The quality is chiefly shown in its color. which should be of a brownish white. As a pound is considered sufficient to tie about two thousand buds or grafts, that amount would last a long time, if kept dry, on a private place. It may also be used for general tying around the greenhouses, among tender plants, because of its breadth in comparison with string .- THE HUNTSVILLE WHOLESALE NURSERIES PRICE LIST.

RATES .- As we send this list to the trade only. we make the difference in prices between the 10, 100 and 1000 rates very slight—simply sufficient, as a rule, to cover the difference in the expense of handling in the smaller numbers. We uniformly tie in bunches of 10, when consistent with the order, and we suggest to our customers to make their orders for varieties in multiples of 10 as far as practicable. Orders for 50 and not over 300 trees, if for not less than 10 of a variety, will be charged at the rate per hundred. orders requiring 300 trees or more, and not less than 10 of a variety, will be filed at the lowest Orders for less than 10 trees of quoted prices. Orders for less than 10 trees of one variety, will be charged at the rate per ten.

SEASON.-Our packing and shipping season

begins by the 20th of September, and continues until about the first of March. We have great advantages to offer here in early shipments for the North in Spring. We do not accept orders for trees we do not grow, as we never buy trees to sell again. You can depend upon us for fresh dug trees. Each order is taken up separately, and not until it is wanted for shipment.

SHIPPING DIRECTIONS.—We respectfully beg our patrons to furnish us with explicit directions as to shipping, and the mode of conveyance tions as to supply and the mode of conveyance by which they desire trees forwarded. When no particular directions are given, we forward according to the best of our judgment. But in no case do we assume any responsibility as to safe activery and condition of Trees and Plants after a proper shipment by us.

RELEASE.—When prepayment of freight is not required, we will Release and Guarantee, and take forwarder's receipt and mail to consignee. take forwarder's receipt and mail to consignee. It is left to the option of the shipper of trees over some railroads, whether he will release them or not under the clause "Value less than \$5.00 per 100 lbs." If released under this clause, the freight is less on roads governed by this classification, and we will assume it to be proper classification, and we will assume it to be proper to make this release, without reference to the value of the trees, unless instructed to the contrary. This clause does not apply upon roads under some of the district classifications, and because of this confusion we will not be held responsible for any oversight to release, unless instructed by our customers. Claims for delay or loss must be made to the forwarders.

PACKAGES.—The cost of package must be added to the prices quoted in this list as follows: Boxes 30 inches square, from 7½ to 9 feet long, as the trees may require, each \$2.50; boxes 24 inches, \$2.00; boxes 18 inches, \$1.50; bales from 25c. to 75c. each.

PACKING.-Goods will be packed in moss, and especial care taken to insure their arrival in the best condition.

ASSORTMENTS .- We do not require customers to take an assortment they do not wish, but will to take an assortment they do not wish, outwill sell one variety alone if desired. If any substi-tution can be allowed, either in grade or variety, it should be so stated when making the order. As a rule we do not substitute without permission.

CAUTION.—We accept all orders upon the condition that they shall be void, should any injury befall the trees from frost, hail, storm, fire, or other causes over which we have no control

If trees show any signs of shrivelling upon arrival, they can usually be restored by being thoroughly watered and buried entirely under the ground for two or three days. Should there be any frost in the tree appears arrival that should not be in the trees upon arrival, they should not be removed from the box until the frost is all out. The box should be placed in the cellar or protected in some other way. The presence of frost in the boxes is not to be considered an evidence of bad condition, as we pack to secure the trees against damage, if the frost is allowed to come out in the natural way.
