

- Not aware of language tools.



## Nambi

**Nurse from Paraguay**

- Speaks Guarani and Spanish.
- Contributes content in Guarani from her laptop.
- Basic use of language tools.



## Rakha

**Musician from India in Belgium**

- Speaks Tamil and very basic English.
- Searches and consumes content from the hotel PC.
- Not aware of language tools.



## Lev

**Professor from Israel**

- Speaks Russian Hebrew and studies Old Aramaic.
- Contributes content from his PC.
- Advanced use of language tools.

# Other deliverables

- Finally traction Unicode Common Locale Data Repository (CLDR). See mediawiki-i18n mailing list
- Newsletter sent to 4,800 translators of translatewiki.net
- Lots of code reviewed, although gerrit poses a challenge
