**SUBJECT:** Scrap Machinery and Equipment Located in Arsenals, Aircraft  
and Private Munitions Plants.

**TO :** See Distribution

1. Recently, the Hyogo Military Government Team requested authority to release machines and equipment inventoried as 3rd class items but subsequently reclassified as scrap on the evaluation report. The request was for permission to release the items from reparations custody and control. In the 3rd indorsement to this request, SCAP made the following reply, which is forwarded for your information:

"1. Machinery and equipment located in arsenals, aircraft and private munitions plants in Hyogo Prefecture, which is listed in inclosure to basic communication and which was classified by evaluation committees as scrap, may be released from reparations custody provided such machinery and equipment is actually used as melt-down scrap.

"2. The instructions furnished to the evaluation committees stated that all machinery and equipment with a salvage value were to be included in the evaluation report as such equipment could be rebuilt. If, however, the machinery in question could be used only as melt-down scrap or the equivalent in wood or brick, it was to be omitted from the inventory and evaluation reports."

2. In the 4th indorsement by Headquarters Eighth Army, the following instructions were given:

"Surveillance will be exercised to assure that released machines are actually used as scrap and not salvaged in whole or in part. It will be ample if such disposition is assured by irreparable damage to various component parts at the time of release. This headquarters will be advised upon the completion of the action."
