Proposed Ship Scrapping Law

1. During the past several weeks, representatives of the Ministry of Transportation have been trying to secure favorable reaction by CTS to a ship scrapping proposal. When a draft was finally presented a few days ago, they were told that CTS must strongly recommend against it since its enactment would be extremely embarrassing to SCAP.

2. In addition to several other grave faults, it contains a crudely concealed but readily computable ship construction subsidy. This is thoroughly opposed by American and European ship operators and the representatives of some governments have already repeatedly discussed the matter with CTS. The mere presentation of this legislation to the Diet may be expected to cause strong representations through commercial and diplomatic channels - all of them highly critical.

3. Since there is every indication that the Japanese Government hopes to obtain SCAP clearance by rushing this through at the last minute, this C/N is hand delivered to advise Government Section that the proposal is thoroughly objectionable because it contravenes and will embarrass SCAP policy. CTS is prepared to give further comment on any revised draft which may be submitted.

Partial Amendment to the Government
Purchase of Low Efficiency Vessels
Bill.

Proposed by YAMAGATA Katsumi (L)

The Government Purchase of Low Efficiency Vessels Bill shall be partially amended as follows.

In Article 10, "a bank" shall read "a bank or banks".

Article 11 shall be amended as follows:--

Article 11. In the contract for purchase it shall be stipulated that the seller of the vessel to the Government shall not make a request for repayment of the money paid into the special deposit account according to the provisions of the preceding Article in any case other than the case where the debts mentioned in the following items is to be paid, the case where such debts have been completely payed or the case where there is no such debts.

- (1) The retirement allowances to be paid due to the labor agreement which may be concluded between the seller of the vessel and labor unions organized by his employees in connection with the sale of vessel under this Law;
- (2) The debts which the seller of the vessel owes concerning the vessel concerned at the time of promulgation of this Law.
- (3) The debts which the person who has sold the vessel concerned to the Government comes to owe due

Proposed Amendment to the Government

Purchase of Low-Efficiency Vessels Bill

(Presented by TSUBOUCHI, Hachiro, and
other 1) (2)

The Government Purchase of Low-Efficiency Vessels Bill shall be partially amended as follows:

In Article 11, "he repays the debts mentioned in the following each item" shall be added next to "except where" and in item (2) of the same Article, "in connection with the said vessel" shall be added next to "Debts" and the following one item shall be added to the same Article as item (3):

(3) Debts which have come under the possession of the person who sold the said vessel to the Government owing to the purchase of the Sempaku Kodan's share mentioned in Article 8 item (1) or to the lapse of the priority right or mortgage mentioned in (2) of the same Article.

In paragraph 1 of the Supplementary Provision, "September 1" shall be amended as "October 1".

In paragraphs 3 and 4 of the Supplementary Provisions, "August 31" shall be amended as "September 30" respectively.
