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Background

Capacity development for underrepresented communities

- Implemented during 2022 & 2023
- The aim: reaching out to underrepresented communities in order to get them involved in the Wikimedia movement
- Two types of underrepresented communities:
 - O 1) speakers of endangered minority languages
 - O 2) users of sign languages

Challenges - Macedonian Sign Language

- 1) Difficulties in communication
- 2) Discrimination in the society
- 3) Comprehension of scientific terminology

Implementation - Macedonian Sign Language

- Sessions for recording videos
- Seminar

Lessons learnt - Macedonian Sign Language

- 1) Collaboration with a sign language interpreter is a must
- 2) Sign language users are generally not fluent in the native language spoken within their family
- 3) Working with a sign language community requires innovating in free knowledge

Project Goal

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Identifying high-impact topics for users of the Macedonian Sign Language as well as producing videos that document the identified topics as a new form of knowledge in collaboration with professional sing language interpreters

Research phase

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Research phase is consisted of:

- 1. Conducting research
- 2. Compilation of lists

Research phase

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- Identification of relevant high-impact economic and legal terms
- Engagement with economic and legal experts
- Help of sign language interpreters
- Creating small council with users of the Macedonian Sign Language
- Compiling a lists of one hundred economic and legal terms

Implementation phase

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In the implementation phase we plan to conducte the following activities:

- 1. Preparing interpretations
- 2. Recording videos
- 3. Post-production
- 4. Uploading videos
- 5. Promoting videos







Implementation phase

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The implementation phase will consist of the process of producing the videos documenting explanations of the economic and legal terms on the article lists in the Macedonian Sign Language. In this phase, the sign language interpretations will have to prepare an interpretation for each term with assistance provided by the experts, a professional video production company will be hired to produce high-quality videos, and the recorded videos will be uploaded to Wikimedia Commons and shared with the members of the Macedonian Sign Language community

Evalution phase

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This phase will include the following activities:

- 1. Project evaluation
- 2. Reporting
- 3. Storytelling

Evalution phase

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- Measuring the project outcomes
- Identifying the strengths and weaknesses from its implementation
- Communicating the results and telling the story with like-minded communities in the movement
- Indicator of how much value was added for the Macedonian Sign Language community
- The positive practices which can be replicated in implementing similar projects
