INVITATION TO BID

Procurement of Pistol, 9mm: Striker Fired

1. The *Department of National Defense (DND)*, through the General Appropriations Act (GAA) for FY 2023 under Program 4, intends to apply the sum of ***One Billion Seven Hundred Eighty-Two Million Pesos (P1,782,000,000.00)*** being the ABC to payments under the contract for the Procurement of Pistol, 9mm: Striker Fired. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The DND now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods are as follows:

Bidders should have completed, within the last ten (10) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instruction to Bidders).

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary pass/fail criterion as specified in the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (R.A. 9184).


Bidding is open to all interested bidders, whether local or foreign, subject to the conditions for eligibility provided in the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from the DND Bids and Awards Committee (DND BAC 1) Secretariat and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday to Friday excluding holidays.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders starting **September 30, 2023** from the given address below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of Seventy-Five Thousand Pesos (P75,000.00). The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees in person.


It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

6. The DND will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **October 10, 2023, at 10:00A.M.** at DND BAC Conference Room, Left Wing Basement, DND Bldg., Camp General Emilio Aguinaldo, Quezon City and/or through video conferencing or webcasting *via Cisco Webex*, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below, on or before **October 24, 2023, at 10:00A.M.** Late bids shall not be accepted.
8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB Clause 14**.
9. Bid opening shall be on **October 24, 2023, at 10:00A.M.** at the given address below and/or via Cisco Webex. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.
10. In relation to item numbers 6 and 9 above, the DND BAC may conduct the pre-bidding conference and opening of bids via teleconferencing (i.e. Cisco Webex). For this purpose, if interested bidders decide to join such online meetings, they must inform the BAC Secretariat of such intention two (2) days before the scheduled activity.
11. The DND reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.





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

Section II. Instruction to Bidders

1. Scope of Bid

1.1. The Procuring Entity, **DEPARTMENT OF NATIONAL DEFENSE**, wishes to receive Bids for the Procurement of Pistol, 9mm: Striker Fired.

The Procurement Project (referred to herein as "Project") is composed of one (1) Lot, the details of which are described in Section VII (Technical Specifications).

2. Funding Information

2.1. The GOP through the source of funding as indicated below for 2023 in the amount of **ONE BILLION SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO MILLION PESOS (P1,782,000,000.00)**.

2.2. The source of funding is the General Appropriations Act (GAA) for FY 2023 for Program 4.

3. Bidding Requirements

The Bidding for the Project shall be governed by all the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including its Generic Procurement Manuals and associated policies, rules and regulations as the primary source thereof, while the herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source thereof.

Any amendments made to the IRR and other GPPB issuances shall be applicable only to the ongoing posting, advertisement, or IB by the BAC through the issuance of a supplemental or bid bulletin.

The Bidder, by the act of submitting its Bid, shall be deemed to have verified and accepted the general requirements of this Project, including other factors that may affect the cost, duration and execution or implementation of the contract, project, or work and examine all instructions, forms, terms, and project requirements in the Bidding Documents.

4. Corrupt, Fraudulent, Collusive, and Coercive Practices

The Procuring Entity, as well as the Bidders and Suppliers, shall observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of the contract. They or through an agent shall not engage in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, and obstructive practices defined under Annex "I" of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 or other integrity violations in competing for the Project.

5. Eligible Bidders

5.1. Only Bids of Bidders found to be legally, technically, and financially capable will be evaluated.

5.2. Foreign ownership exceeding those allowed under the rules may participate pursuant to:

- i. When a Treaty or International or Executive Agreement as provided in Section 4 of the RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR allow foreign bidders to participate;
ii. Citizens, corporations, or associations of a country, included in the list issued by the GPPB, the laws or regulations of which grant reciprocal rights or privileges to citizens, corporations, or associations of the Philippines;
iii. When the Goods sought to be procured are not available from local suppliers; or
iv. When there is a need to prevent situations that defeat competition or restrain trade.

5.3. Pursuant to Section 23.4.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No.9184, the Bidder shall have an SLCC that is at least one (1) contract similar to the Project the value of which, adjusted to current prices using the PSA's CPI, must be at least equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC, or in view of the Procuring Entity that imposition of the provision of Section 23.4.1.3 of the IRR of RA 9184 will likely result to monopoly that will defeat the purpose of public bidding, the Bidder should comply with the following requirements:

- a. Completed at least two (2) similar contracts, the aggregate contract amounts should be equivalent to at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the ABC for each Sub-Lot; and
b. The largest of these similar contracts must be equivalent to at least half of the percentage of the ABC as required above.

5.4. The Bidders shall comply with the eligibility criteria under Section 23.4.1 of the 2016 IRR of RA No. 9184.

6. Origin of Goods

There is no restriction on the origin of goods other than those prohibited by a decision of the UN Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the UN, subject to Domestic Preference requirements under ITB Clause 18.

7. Subcontracts

The Procuring Entity has prescribed that subcontracting is not allowed.

10. Documents Comprising the Bid: Eligibility and Technical Components

10.1. The first envelope shall contain the following eligibility and technical documents of the Bid as specified in Section VIII (Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents)

10.2. The Bidder's SLCC as indicated in ITB Clause 5.3 should have been completed within ten (10) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.

10.3. If the eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents for submission to the BAC are in foreign language other than English, it must be accompanied by a translation in English, which shall be authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment, post, or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines. Similar to the required authentication above, for Contracting Parties to the Apostille Convention, only the translated documents shall be authenticated through an apostille pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 13-2019 dated 23 May 2019. The English translation shall govern, for purposes of interpretation of the bid.

13. Bid and Payment Currencies

13.1. For Goods that the Bidder will supply from outside the Philippines, the bid prices may be quoted in the local currency or tradeable currency accepted by the BSP at the discretion of the Bidder. However, for purposes of bid evaluation, Bids denominated in foreign currencies, shall be converted to Philippine currency based on the exchange rate as published in the BSP reference rate bulletin on the day of the bid opening.

13.2. Payment of the contract price shall be made in **Philippine Pesos**.

14. Bid Security

14.1. The Bidder shall submit a Bid Securing Declaration or any form of Bid Security in the amount indicated in the **BDS**, which shall be not less than the percentage of the ABC in accordance with the schedule in the **BDS**.

14.2. The bid security should be valid for **One Hundred Twenty (120) Calendar Days from the date of bid opening**. Any Bid not accompanied by an acceptable bid security shall be rejected by the Procuring Entity as non-responsive.

15. Sealing and Marking of Bids

Each Bidder shall submit one copy of the first and second components of its Bid.

The Procuring Entity may request additional hard copies and/or electronic copies of the Bid. However, failure of the Bidders to comply with the said request shall not be a ground for disqualification.

If the Procuring Entity allows the submission of bids through online submission or any other electronic means, the Bidder shall submit an electronic copy of its Bid, which must be digitally signed. An electronic copy that cannot be opened or is corrupted shall be considered non-responsive and, thus, automatically disqualified.

16. Deadline for Submission of Bids

The Bidders shall submit on the specified date and time and either at its physical address or through online submission as indicated in paragraph 7 of the IB.

17. Opening and Preliminary Examination of Bids

17.1. The BAC shall open the Bids in public at the time, on the date, and at the place specified in paragraph 9 of the **IB**. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance. In case videoconferencing, webcasting or other similar technologies will be used, attendance of participants shall likewise be recorded by the BAC Secretariat.

In case the Bids cannot be opened as scheduled due to justifiable reasons, the rescheduling requirements under Section 29 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 shall prevail.

17.2. The preliminary examination of bids shall be governed by Section 30 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

18. Domestic Preference

The Procuring Entity will grant a margin of preference for the purpose of comparison of Bids in accordance with Section 43.1.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

19. Detailed Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

19.1. The Procuring Entity's BAC shall immediately conduct a detailed evaluation of all Bids rated "*passed*," using non-discretionary pass/fail criteria. The BAC shall consider the conditions in the evaluation of Bids under Section 32.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

19.2. If the Project allows partial bids, bidders may submit a proposal on any of the lots or items, and evaluation will be undertaken on a per lot or item basis, as the case may be. In this case, the Bid Security as required by **ITB** Clause 14 shall be submitted for each lot or item separately.

II. OBJECTIVES:

- a. To ascertain compliance to standards and specification;
- b. To determine the reliability and durability of the weapon or the pistol when subjected to adverse field condition; and
- c. To determine the safety of the user when it is used in various environment condition.

III. GUIDELINES:

- a. A representative sample of the pistol shall be properly segregated, packed, marked and secured by the Manufacturer during the Post-Qualification Test as stated on Paragraph VI. Allocation of Samples;
- b. A representative sample of the pistol shall be randomly picked-up from the respective lot by the PDI Team and properly segregated, packed, marked and secured as stated on Paragraph VI. Allocation of Samples;
- c. Ammunition to be used for the entire series of tests should only come from one lot, and should be kept in its original shipping containers until use. A general visual examination of the ammunition should be made after it is removed

d. Sample Pistols will be numbered based on the test procedures as stated on Paragraph VI. Allocation of Samples;

e. If ever there is inconsistency of entry between the Technical Specification (TS), and Test & Acceptance Procedures (TAP), the TS will prevail and

f. The manufacturer shall ensure that international safety standards are accorded to AFP personnel during the conduct of test and inspection.

IV. PROCEDURES:

A. COMPLETENESS INSPECTION AND RANDOM SAMPLING:

The Technical Inspection and Acceptance Committee (TIAC) for Ordnance-Firepower/ Pre-Delivery Inspection (PDI) Team shall check the completeness of the goods and conduct random sampling from the lot or lots. The samples shall be properly segregated, packed, marked and secured by the members. (See Para VI – Allocation of Representative Samples)

B. TEST AND INSPECTION PARAMETERS:

1. PHYSICAL INSPECTION:

PURPOSE: To determine the overall workmanship, conformity to TS of the packaging and its markings to ensure that the inspected item shall be free from defects and meet the requirements of the AFP conformance of the physical characteristics of the pistol to the required TS.

PROCEDURES:

- a. Visually check the packaging;
- b. Inspect the presence and appropriateness of the markings;
- c. Inspect for signs of deterioration, condition of handles, loose, missing or incorrect positioned parts

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
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

2. WEIGHT AND DIMENSIONAL INSPECTION:

PURPOSE: To determine the pistol is compliant within the required TS.

PROCEDURES:

- a. The sample pistols, its parts or components shall be measured by using a weighing scale, go and no-go gauges, vernier caliper, micrometer caliper or other appropriate measuring instruments. All measuring instruments shall be calibrated for a minimum of 1-year prior date of test; and
- b. Record all results and observations.

STANDARDS:

- a. Weight and dimensions shall be according to TS; and
- b. The sample pistol shall be free from defects as stated in Paragraph VII. Classifications of Defects.

3. MAGAZINE CATCH TEST:

PURPOSE: To determine the magazine assembly's fitness with the pistol.

PROCEDURES:

- a. Insert the magazine assembly (without ammunition) to the pistol and press the release button;
- b. Transfer the magazine release button to the other side, insert magazine then press the magazine release button; and
- c. Record all results and observations.

STANDARDS:

- a. The magazine should fall freely with its own weight when magazine release button is pressed on either side; and


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
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
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b. The magazine should be free from any defects as stated in Paragraph VII. Classifications of Defects.

4. INTERCHANGEABILITY TEST:

PURPOSE: To determine the interchangeability of the pistol to a similar pistol.

PROCEDURES:

- a. Disassemble all pistols (Detailed disassembly) and put together the disassembled pistol into the box;
- b. Mixed the disassembled pistols and reassemble;
- c. Subject the pistol for functional test for not less than 45 rounds of ammunition; and
- d. Record all results and observations

STANDARDS:

- a. There should be no unnecessary force applied during the assembly of the pistol;
- b. All parts should be fitted to each pistol without any adjustments or manipulation of the parts;
- c. The weapon should meet the functional firing requirements without any malfunction or stoppage; and
- d. The sample pistols should be free from any defects as stated in Paragraph VII. Classifications of Defects.

5. FUNCTIONAL TEST

PURPOSE: To determine the functional reliability of the pistol.

PROCEDURES:

- a. Hand-held firing: Pistol will be fired manually with or without support;
- b. Each pistol will be fired forty-five (45) rounds at the speed of at least one (1) round per second;
- c. Observe for any malfunction/stoppage and any damages on the spent cartridge case; and
- d. Record all results and observations.


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
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
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STANDARDS:

- a. There shall be no malfunctions/stoppages attributable to the pistol;
- b. There shall be no sign of ring marks, bulges, cracks, or splits on cartridge case due to defective barrel; and
- c. The sample pistols should be free from any defects as stated in Paragraph VII. Classifications of Defects.

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6. CHEMICAL RESISTANCE TEST

PURPOSE: To determine if the pistol protective coating and the non-metallic parts will be affected by the chemical.

PROCEDURES:

a. Remove the protective oil coating in the pistol using soap and warm water and rinse. The pistol shall be immersed in salt water solution (970ml H2O + 30g NaLC) for 24 hours, and then the pistol shall be taken out of the solution and allowed to stand for 72 hours/three (3) days. After the required time, the pistol shall be examined for any sign of corrosion; and

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b. The pistol's lower receiver shall be immersed in the following chemical listed below and allowed to immerse for 24 hours. After which, the lower receiver shall be taken out of the solution and inspected for any damage/s;

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- 1) Bore cleaner – MIL-C-372 (RBC).
- 2) Carbon-removing compound – P-C-111, type II
- 3) Cleaner, lubricant, preservative – MIL-L-63460 (CLP)
- 4) Diesel fuel – VV-F-800
- 5) Gasoline – VV-G-1690
- 6) Lubricating-oil – MIL-L-46000 (LSA)

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c. Record all results and observations.

STANDARDS:

- a. Coating on metal parts shall maintain its integrity, and shows no evidence of corrosion within the pistol or its parts;
- b. No degradation should be observed in the non-metallic component of the pistol lower receiver; and
- c. The sample pistols should be free from any defects as stated in Paragraph VII. Classifications of Defects.

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7. COOK OFF TEST:

PURPOSE: To determine the pistol chamber will not be hot enough to cause the chambered cartridge to ignite (cook off) based on the required TS.

PROCEDURES:

- a. The test should be done with weapons firmly hand-held or held in appropriate mount;
- b. Subject the pistol to continuous firing for two hundred (200) rounds replacing the magazines as quickly as possible. Thereafter, one (1) round of ammo loaded in the magazine which shall be inserted to the pistol and immediately chambered;
- c. Observe the pistol for five (5) minutes and the test will be terminated after ten (10) minutes waiting time;
- d. Allow the pistol to cool enough to start a new trial when the temperature measurement taken on the barrel is within +2°C (35.6 °F) of the ambient temperature;
- e. The test will be repeated three (3) times; and
- f. Record all results and observations

STANDARDS:

- a. The weapon should not cook-off within five (5) minutes starting from the time the round is chambered; and
- b. The sample pistols should be free from any defects as stated in Paragraph VII. Classifications of Defects.

Note: Pistol that cooked-off will be considered failed.

8. ACCURACY TEST:

PURPOSE: To determine the accuracy of the pistol to the center of projectile impacts and to the point of aim.


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
- a. The pistol must be fired hand held in supported position or in mechanical fixture;
- b. Pistol is allowed to fire not more than five (5) rounds for warm-up shots;

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- c. Fire ten (10) rounds of ammunition (one lot only) to a target located at 25 meters distance from the muzzle of the weapon;
- d. The target shall then be checked to determine that the accuracy requirement has been met;
- e. If the pistol had flyer hits, a re-test will be done for confirmation; and
- f. Record all results and observations.

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STANDARDS:

- a. The standard mean radii of ten (10) rounds shot group shall be according to TS; and
- b. The sample pistols should be free from any defects as stated in Paragraph VII. Classifications of Defects.

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9. ADVERSE CONDITION TEST:

a) WATER IMMERSION AND SPRAY TEST:

PURPOSE: To determine the reliability of the pistol when immersed on water and its performance during heavy rainfall.

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PROCEDURES:

- (1) The pistol will be cleaned and oiled based on manual;
- (2) Insert fully loaded magazine, and load pistol, then after, engage the safety if applicable;
- (3) Provide spray of water to simulate a heavy rainfall with a rate of about 10 + 1cm/hr (3.9 + 0.4 in/hr) from a height enough to direct the spray over the entire pistol;
- (4) Immerse the loaded pistol for a minimum of one (1) minute in an appropriate container filled with tap water (except for the replacement magazine) with a minimum deep of 609.6mm (24 inch). Then after, remove the pistol, muzzle down for 2 seconds to drain the water then fire all rounds;
- (5) The pistol and the replacement magazine are subjected to the water spray continuously throughout the test;
- (6) Each pistol should consume 30 rounds of ammunition for this test; and

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(7) Record all results and observations.

STANDARDS:

(1) The pistol must fire without malfunction/stoppage and shall not be damaged; and

(2) The sample pistols should be free from any defects as stated in Paragraph VII. Classifications of Defects.

Note:

(a) Failure to fire due to defective ammunition is not part of pistol defects for this test, except for firing pin and firing pin spring failure; and

(2) If malfunction occurs due to defective ammunition, the test will be resumed from the start.

b). SAND AND DUST EXPOSURE TEST:

PURPOSE: To determine whether the pistol will be able to fire without malfunction and stoppage even when exposed to sand and dust.

PROCEDURES:

(1) The pistol will be cleaned and oiled based on manual;

(2) Insert fully loaded magazine to the pistol, and load one (1) round and place the safety lever on safe position (if applicable). It will be placed in a dust box and exposed to the dust for one (1) minute on topside and one (1) minute upside down. The dust mixture will be made by mixing nine (9) lbs of grade 0 sand with one (1) lb of clean silica core sand, which passed through fine mesh wire for at least 2.5mm width and 4.5mm height;

(3) The firer will clean the pistol by tapping, shaking and wiping with bare hands, for 30 seconds;

(4) After which, fire the pistol for at least one (1) shot per second continuously;

(5) Each pistol should consume 30 rounds of ammunition for this test; and

(6) Record all results and observations

STANDARDS:

(1) The pistol must fire without malfunction/stoppage and shall not be damaged; and


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
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
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(2) The sample pistols should be free from any defects as stated in Paragraph VII. Classifications of Defects.

c) MUD IMMERSION TEST

PURPOSE: To determine if the pistol will still be operational after being immersed in mud.

PROCEDURES:

(1) The pistol shall be cleaned and oiled based on the manual. The muzzle of the pistol will be taped to prevent seepage of mud;

(2) The pistol, inserted with fully loaded magazine with one (1) round chambered and the safety lever placed on safe position (if applicable) will be immersed in the mud for fifteen (15) seconds;

(3) The mud mixture shall be made of 4.5 kg (10 lbs) Montmorillonite clay, 1,000g (2.2lbs) SIL-CO-SIL 125 and about 45.41l (48qts) of water. The amount of water to be added to the sand and clay mixture will be varying with the moisture content of the components. The required viscosity of mixture should be 4,600 ±200 centipoises as determined with a Brookfield viscometer;

(4) The firer will be allowed to clean the pistol for 30 seconds by tapping, shaking and wiping the congested area of the pistol with bare hands;

(5) The tape will be removed from the muzzle of the pistol and after which, forty-five (45) rounds will be fired from the pistol for at least one (1) shot per second continuously. There will be a change of magazine;

(6) Any simple malfunction such as slide fails to open or closed (battery) during firing maybe corrected through simple outside manipulations such as tapping the pistols with bare hands only;

(7) If the pistol fails to fire, the magazine may be replaced with a new magazine containing the remaining quantity of ammunition;

(8) If pistol still malfunctions, released the magazine and engage the slide to the rear using the slide stop. It may be cleaned using not more than one (1) liter of water to wash away the excessive mud, without disassembling the pistol;

(9) Each pistol should have fired 45 rounds of ammunition without disassembling the pistol; and

(10) Record all results and observations.

STANDARDS:

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
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

10. ROUGH HANDLING TEST (Drop Safety Test):

PURPOSE: To determine the safety of the pistol when accidentally dropped.

- a. The pistol shall be loaded with blank ammunition (primer only);
- b. The pistol is dropped once, either mechanically or manually, from a height of 1.5 meters onto a clean, level, concrete surface in each of the following orientation;

1	Major axis horizontal (normal firing position).
2	Major axis vertical, muzzle facing up.
3	Major axis vertical, muzzle down.
4	Major axis 45° from vertical, muzzle facing up.
5	Major axis 45° from vertical, muzzle down.

- c. Inspect the pistol after each drop. Ascertain the position of safety lever and check if there are no firing pin dents on the cartridge primer;
- d. Test fire each drop tested pistol for not less than fifteen (15) rounds to ensure serviceability; and
- e. Record all results and observations.

STANDARDS:

- a. The pistol shall not fire on impact;
- b. No evidence of firing pin dents on the cartridge primer;
- c. There should be no separation or displacement of parts when dropped;
- d. The pistol should fire without malfunction after it was dropped; and
- e. The sample pistols should be free from any defects as stated in Paragraph VII. Classifications of Defects.

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11. HIGH PRESSURE RESISTANCE TEST:

PURPOSE: To determine if the pistol can withstand the firing of one (1) round Ctg, 9mm: M905: HPT.

PROCEDURES:

- a. Pistol will be fired remotely using a one (1) round Ctg 9mm: M905, HPT (having a chamber pressure of at least 50,000 psi); and
- b. After proof firing, pistol shall be examined for cracks, deformations, and other evidence of damage; and cartridge cases shall be visually examined for bulges, splits, rings, and other defects caused by defective barrels.

STANDARDS:

- a. The barrel assembly, slide and lower receiver shall be free from cracks, seams, and other injurious defects as evidenced by visual and magnetic particle inspection;
- b. The pistol lower receiver should have no evidence of crack and loosened mated/welded parts;
- c. The pistol and its parts should be free from any damage after the test; and
- d. The cartridge case should be free for bulges, splits, rings, and other defects caused by defective barrels.

Note:

- 1. Any test pistol showing evidence of cracks, seams, loosened mated/welded parts on major components during visual inspection or magnetic particle inspection will be considered failed;
- 2. Any damage on pistol action parts during visual inspection is considered a major defect;
- 3. Cartridge case with evidence of bulges, splits, rings, and other defects caused by defective barrel is considered a major defect; and
- 4. In case the HPT ammunition is not available on the market, the manufacturer may reload/assemble the said ammunition provided that the required PSI is attained

12. LABORATORY TEST:

PURPOSES:

- a. To determine the metal integrity of the barrel and slide after it was subjected to reliability and durability test and high-pressure resistance test; and

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
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
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b. To determine the metal composition of the barrel and upper receiver (slide).

PROCEDURES:

a. Subject the barrel and slide to Magnetic Particle Test (Magnaflux) after subjecting to endurance and high-pressure resistance tests in a certified test laboratory by a Third Party Company in the country where the test was conducted; and

b. Subject the barrel and slide to metal composition analysis in a certified test laboratory by a Third-Party Company in the country where the test was conducted.

STANDARDS:

a. The barrel and slide shall maintain its integrity and no surface defects/cracks shall be found; and

b. The material used on the sample pistols should be the same composition.

Note:

1. Test barrel and slide with evidence of cracks seams and other injuries as determined by a laboratory inspection shall be considered failed; and
2. Different metal composition used as the result of the Metal Composition Analysis shall be considered critical.

13. RELIABILITY AND DURABILITY TEST (Endurance Test):

PURPOSE: To determine the pistol functional reliability and durability when subjected to endurance firing of 6,000 rounds.

PROCEDURES:

a. Disassemble, thoroughly clean, inspect, lubricate and reassemble the test pistol;

b. Test each pistol in accordance with the firing procedures (number of rounds, firing cycles, mode of fire sequence) as specified below. All firing is done with weapons firmly hand-held or held in appropriate mount;

c. The basic firing cycle is **120 rounds** for at least 1 round per second and observing 10 minutes cool-down for every cycle;

d. Lubricate the pistol without disassembly after **600 rounds** (5 cycles of 120 rds) and allow to cool-down for 10 minutes before resuming to fire. Bore swabbing is not authorized;

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
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
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e. The pistol shall be disassembled, cleaned, lubricated and visually inspected for any damage/s after every **1,200 rounds** (10 cycles of 120 rds) within 10 minutes duration only. Firer shall not exceed the allotted time for cool-down, cleaning and lubricating. The use of armorer's tool/kit is allowed. However, replacement of damaged parts is not authorized;

f. The test will be continued even if the pistol has damaged action parts without prejudice to safety considerations and that it shall function normally without outside manipulation;

g. The tests shall be repeated until **6,000 rounds** of cartridge, 9mm, Ball, M882 had been fired;

h. The use of blower or compressed air during cleaning and cool-down is not authorized;

i. The pistol reloading or replacement of magazine during the firing cycles will be not more than three (3) seconds; and

j. Record all results and observations.

STANDARDS:

a. The pistol should fire 6,000 rounds continuously without replacement of any parts;

b. The pistol lower receiver should have no evidence of crack and its mated/welded parts should not be loosed;

c. The pistol slide and barrel should have no evidence of crack during visual inspection and when subjected to Laboratory test for Magnetic Particle inspection (Magnaflux); and

d. The sample pistols should not exceed with the required defects as stated in Paragraph VIII. **Acceptance/Rejection Criteria**, Table 5: Reliability and Durability Test (Endurance Test) both for Post Qualification (PQ) and Pre-Delivery Inspection (PDI).
