Traces are requested on BAUER, Friedrich, Austrian citizen born 25 January 1904 in VIENNA, currently residing in VIENNA (no address available as yet). BAUER was formerly a criminal police official, abandoning this profession, necessarily, after 1945, and allegedly has been employed "various places" since 1946. It is known, informally, that BAUER was among the guests of the U.S. in Camp MARCUS ORR after the war, and probably was a member of the RSHA. We would appreciate copies of interrogation reports on BAUER, if such exist (presumably USDIC issued some), which in our experience are only too likely to be available only in the Pentagon.

1. Subject is the chief evaluator at the Dorotheum (state-owned auction shop) in Linz. He was a colonel in the German Army and during the war worked (according to a GRAMEA report) under UTILITY as the IC of an army corps of Heeresgruppe Nord. Before this assignment he was with AST XXVIII in Budapest.
2. SDB files list a Friedrich BAUER, presumed i/w subject, as born 25 January 1904 in Vienna. He was interned at Camp Marcus Orr after the war as an NSDAP member and was again arrested in January 1947 at Bremen. At some date before 1945 he was a Kripo official. In April 1953 his address was listed as Schoengarten 82, Upper Austria. Local and other traces have been instituted, but results are not yet available.
3. Subject is a target of the SRIS in Urfahr.
4. It is requested that PCB inform us whether subject is or was connected with ZIPPER.
