Traces are requested on BAUER, Friedrich, Austrian citizen born 25 January 1904 in VIENNA, currently residing in VIENNA (no address available as yet). BAUER was formerly a criminal police official, abandoning this profession, necessarily, after 1945, and allegedly has been employed "various places" since 1946. It is known, informally, that BAUER was among the guests of the U.S. in Camp MARCUS ORR after the war, and probably was a member of the RSHA. We would appreciate copies of interrogation reports on BAUER, if such exist (presumably USDIC issued some), which in our experience are only too likely to be available only in the Pentagon.

According to an unevaluated report dated 15 Nov 1943, one Friedrich BAUER, not further identified, was attached to the SIPO (German Security Police) at Zichenau, Poland.

Report dated 19 October 1944, "German Service in Rumania"
August Friedrich Baur. National socialist. Bukarest, den 21. Februar 1940.

An OSS report of June 29, 1944, lists among SIPO and SD Personnel in Zichenau-Schroetterberg one Friedrich BAUER, Krim. Koa.

1. Subject is the chief evaluator at the Dorotheum (state-owned auction shop) in Linz. He was a colonel in the German Army and during the war worked (according to a GRAMEBA report) under UTILITI as the IC of an army corps of Heeresgruppe Sued. Before this assignment he was with AST XVIII in Budapest.

2. SOB files list a Friedrich BAUER, presumed 1/w subject, as born 25 January 1904 in Vienna. He was interned at Camp Marcus Orr after the war as an EBNA member and was again arrested in January 1947 at Braunau. At some date before 1945 he was a Krippe official. In April 1953 his address was listed as Seheengarten 82, Upper Austria. Local and other traces have been instituted, but results are not yet available.

3. Subject is a target of the BRIS in Urfahr.

4. It is requested that POB inform us whether subject is or was connected with ZIPFER.
