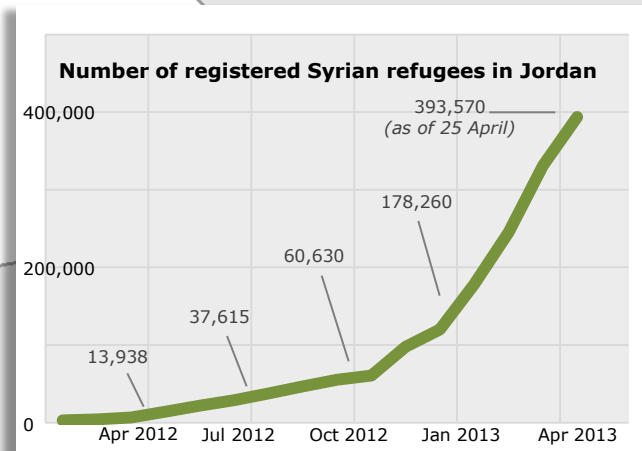


SITUATION

- According to the UN Refugee Agency, as of **25 April 2013**, the number of Syrians seeking refuge in Jordan is estimated to be **448,370**. Of this number, 393,570 have been registered by UNHCR.
- At the moment, there are 4 operational camps: 2 near Ramtha and Irbid, 1 near Mafraq and 1 near Zarqa. The latter, a 5,500 people capacity camp run by the United Arab Red Crescent Society, may expand to a capacity of 30,000.
- Currently, a new camp is being established near the town of Azraq. It will have the capacity to shelter 30,000 refugees.
