The following message from Gen Wright to Gen Willoughby was received at 161135 I September:

"First Marines attacked at 0600 and at 1015 have advanced 1200 yards with strong patrols out to the line (969-1631) to (969-1626). Fifth Marines are along the general line (967-1632) to (968-1631). ROK Marines are working through city of Inchon. Six enemy tanks moving from direction of Seoul reached (972-1633) where they were destroyed by Corsairs. Just reported 10 trucks and 2 tanks destroyed just northwest Seoul by Navy air. Weather excellent."

1. In compliance with Para 23, Section III, GHQ Staff Memo. No. 6, 22 Jan. 49, synopsis of teleconference 131316Z, TT-3755, 13-14 Sept. 50, is submitted herein.

2. Conference was called at the request of OCE representatives, DA, on a number of Engineer items of supply being obtained by FECOM from the ZI. Representatives of GHQ Engineer Section and JLCOM Engineer Section conferred with DA representatives.

3. DA representatives requested clarification or reconciliation of requirements vs. requisitions for POL tanks, 3/4 yd. truck cranes, 50-ton divisional bridges, Bailey bridges, lumber, and sniperscopes. DA also requested status of answer on DA letter containing bill of materials for 500-bed hospital; status of answer on substitution of two 18 ft. power boats for each 25 ft. or 27 ft. power boat required; also whether invasion type POL pipe now on procurement is acceptable instead of heavy duty type pipe requested by FECOM.

a. Clarifying answers were furnished by FECOM representatives where possible, stating that remainder of information would follow by radio. Advice was furnished that answer being airmailed the same date as to building materials for 500-bed hospital, and that substitution of two 18 ft. power boats for each 25 ft. or 27 ft. power boat was concurred in.

b. CINCPAC representatives requested increase of FECOM requirements for Quonset huts from 3,000 to 6,000, and doubling of FECOM requirements for Navy Pontoon Gear (floating docks) with stepped-up delivery. Also requested FECOM be furnished two fathometers. DA representatives furnished information that there was no stock of Quonsets in the ZI, that deliveries of Quonsets from procurement would begin 30 Sept. 50, and that fathometers would be obtained.

1. In compliance with Para 23, Section III, GHQ Staff Memo, No. 6, 22 Jan. 50, synopsis of teleconference 13112, TT-3755, 13-11 Sept. 50, is submitted hereto.

2. Conference was called at the request of GCE representatives, DA, on a number of Engineer items of supply being obtained by FECON from the II. Representatives of GHQ Engineer Section and IJCOM Engineer Section conferred with DA representatives.

3. DA representatives requested clarification or reevaluation of requirements vs. requisitions for FOL tanks, 3 1/2 yd. tank cranes, 50-ton divisional bridges, Bailey bridges, lumber, and antipersopes. DA also requested status of answer on DA letter containing bill of materials for 500-bed hospital; status of answer on substitution of two 18 ft. power posts for each 25 ft. or 27 ft. power post required; also whether invasion type FOL pipe now on procurement is acceptable instead of heavy duty type pipe requested by FECON.

a. Clarifying answers were furnished by FECON representatives where possible, stating that remainder of information would follow by radio. Advice was furnished that answer being awaited the same date as to build- ing materials for 500-bed hospital, and that substitution of two 18 ft. power posts for each 25 ft. or 27 ft. power post was concurred in.

b. GINCEB representatives requested increase of FECON requirements for Gasset nuts from 2,000 to 6,000, and doubling of FECON requirements for Navy Faston Gear (flashing cocks) with stepped-up delivery. Also requested FECON be furnished two lathecutters. DA representatives furnished information that there was no stock of Gasset in the II, that deliveries of non- sets from procurement would begin 30 Sept. 50, and that lathecutters would be obtained.

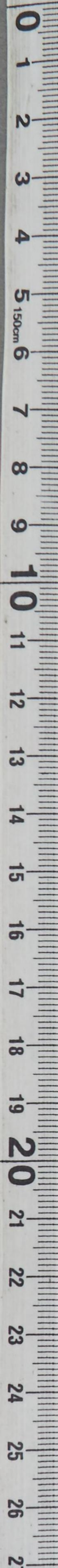

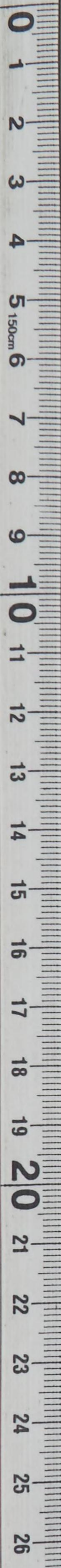
MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD:

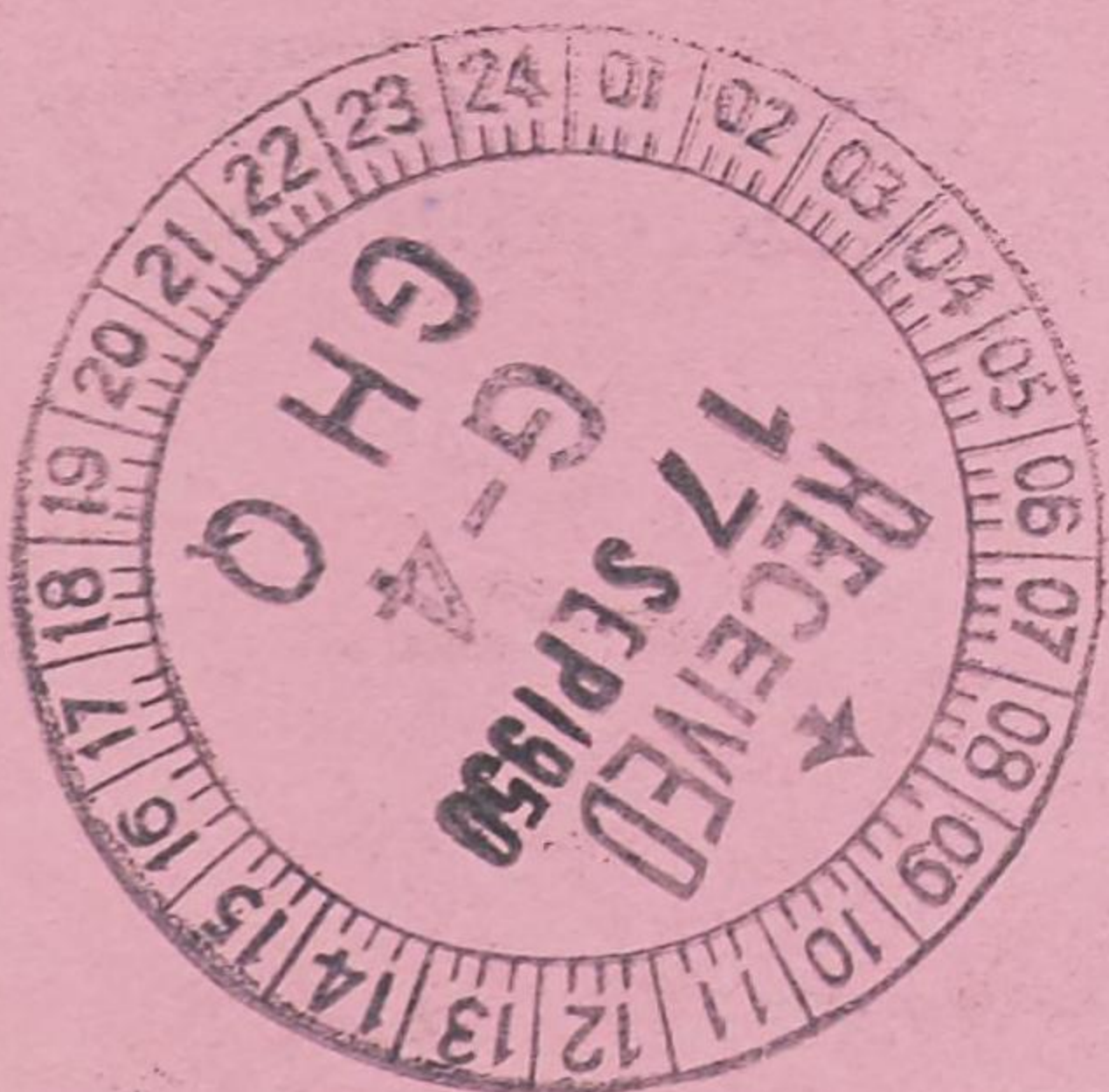
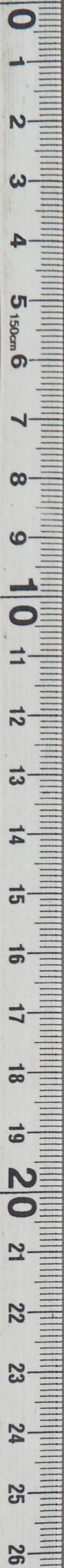

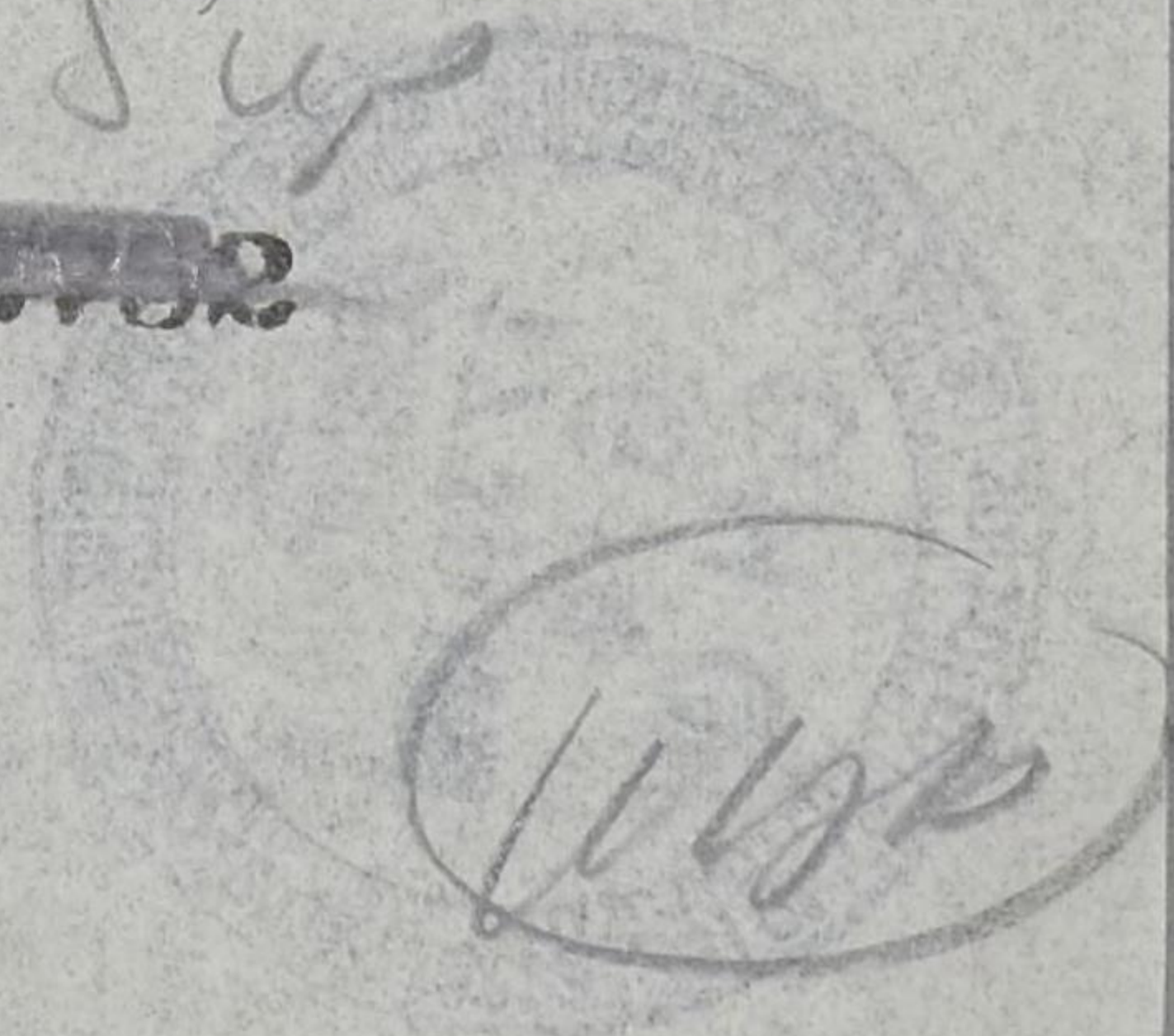
