ARMY ARSENAL (OJI WARD)

This arsenal was engaged chiefly in the production of small arms ammunition up to 25mm in size.

Powder produced in A.O.F. Target #205 was utilized, along with that from other souces of supply in filling the cases and projectiles.

Complete equipment for machining & manufacturing fuzes, shell cases and projectiles was available at this plant.

Ten building had been destroyed by fire raids. These included hospital, the training school, the dining room, and various ware-houses. The raids had no effect on production.

Shortages of materials of all kinds had materially effected production near the close of the war.

Some facilities were available for the manufacture and storage of radio and radar equipment. Most of these machines were dispersed early in the summer of 1945.
