By letters of 5 and 20 June, the Swiss Minister had the honour of transmitting to His Excellency Mr. Mamoru Shigenitsu a protest of the Government of the United Kingdom on the subject of the attack on the survivors of British merchant vessels by Japanese submarines. By the note of 19 July the Legation sent to the Imperial Foreign Office some complementary information about this matter.

The Swiss Legation would be thankful to the Foreign Office if the Foreign Office would communicate the answer of the Imperial Government to the said protest.
