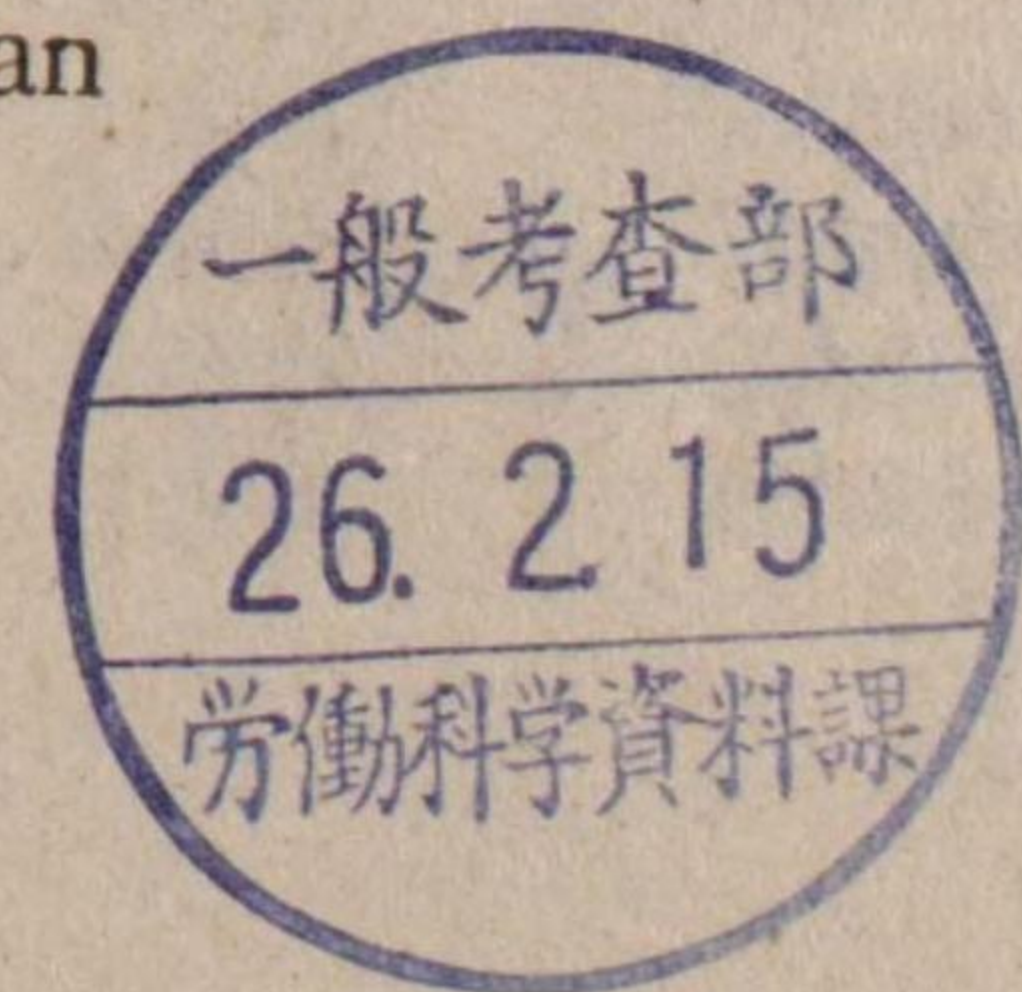

凡 例

1. 本目録は本館に受入れられた図書で整理を了したものを逐次収録する。
但し本号には洋書だけ収録してある。
2. 記載は Dewey の Decimal Classification (D. C.) 14 版により分類してある。
但し法律関係資料 (分類表 340 Law に属すべきもの) は一括して記号 "L" を以て表示し、最初に掲載してある。
同一分類内の排列は、本文分類見出の中を標目の ABC 順にしてある。
3. 目次に代わるものとして、D. C. の主綱表 (Divisions) を掲げてある。本文の見出しもこれによる。
4. 各図書の標目の右端に附せられた数字はその図書の請求番号である。

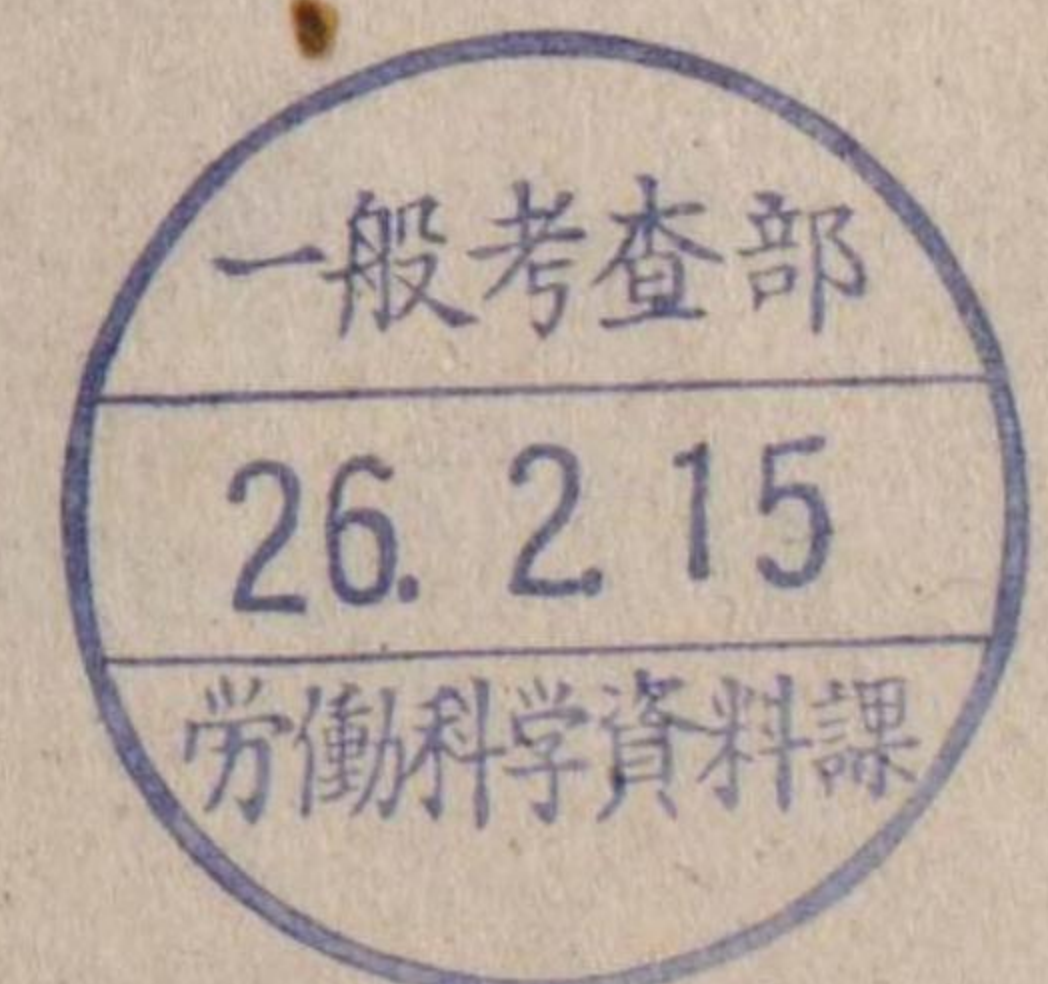

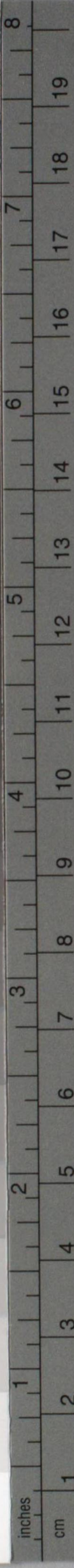
