## INSTRUCTIONS

Paint brushes should be washed clean and dried each time after using. Try color on a piece of spare paper before using on picture, to see that you have the shade wanted. Always begin a picture at the top, and work downward from left to right. The edge of a color may be softened by a clean damp brush.

RED, BLUE and YELLOW, are simple or primary colors, and cannot be made by mixing.

ORANGE, PURPLE and GREEN are compound or secondary colors, and

ORANGE is made by mixing RED and YELLOW

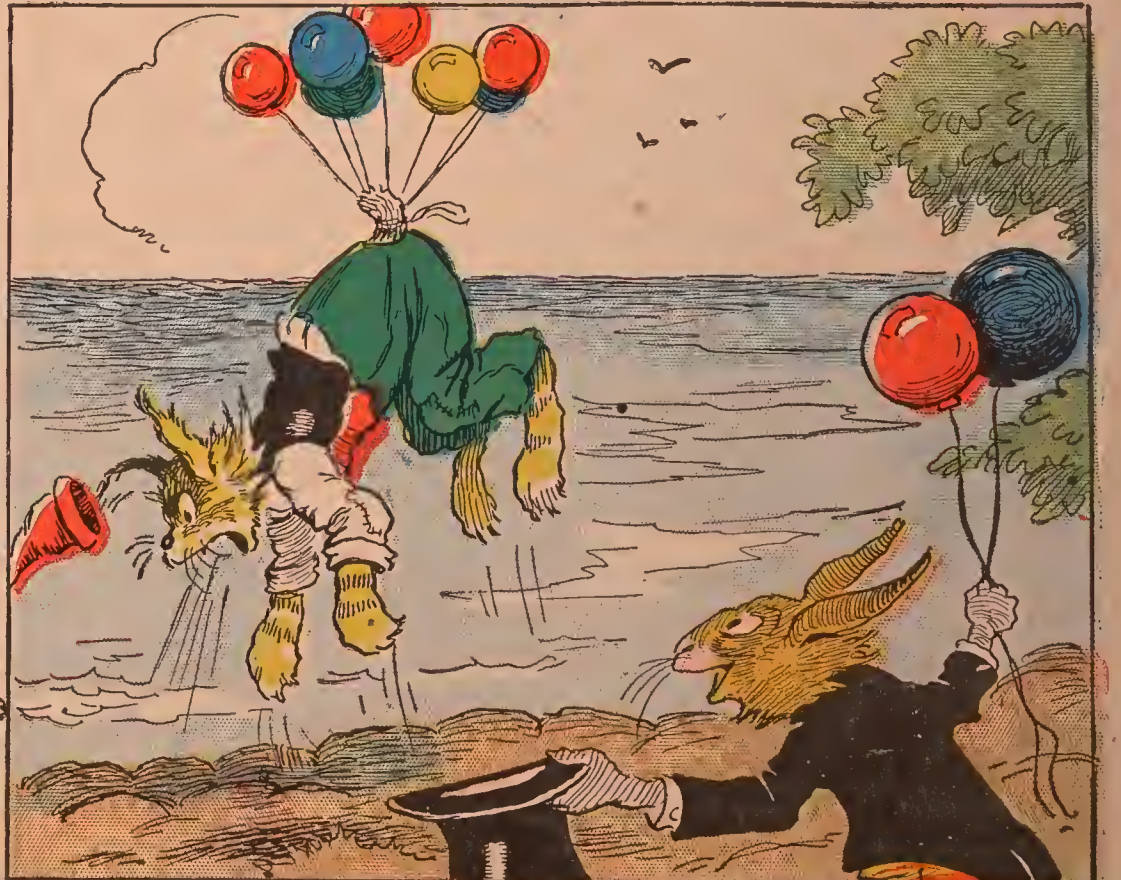
PURPLE is made by mixing RED and BLUE

GREEN is made by mixing YELLOW and BLUE

If young beginners find trouble in using paints, the use of colored crayons is recommended.



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
