A BILL

To be entitled “An Act to exempt from taxation loans made on hypothecation of non-taxable bonds.

1 SECTION 1. *The Congress of the Confederate States of America do*
2 *enact*, That henceforth no tax shall be assessed upon either the
3 principal or the interest of loans made to the Confederate States,
4 upon the hypothecation of bonds of the said States, whereof the
5 principal and interest are exempted from taxation.

1 SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from the passing thereof.
