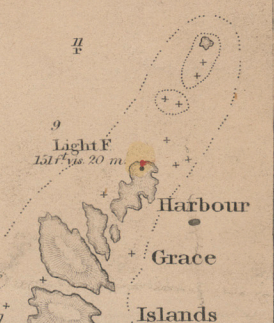
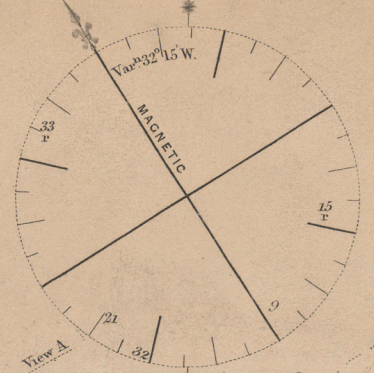
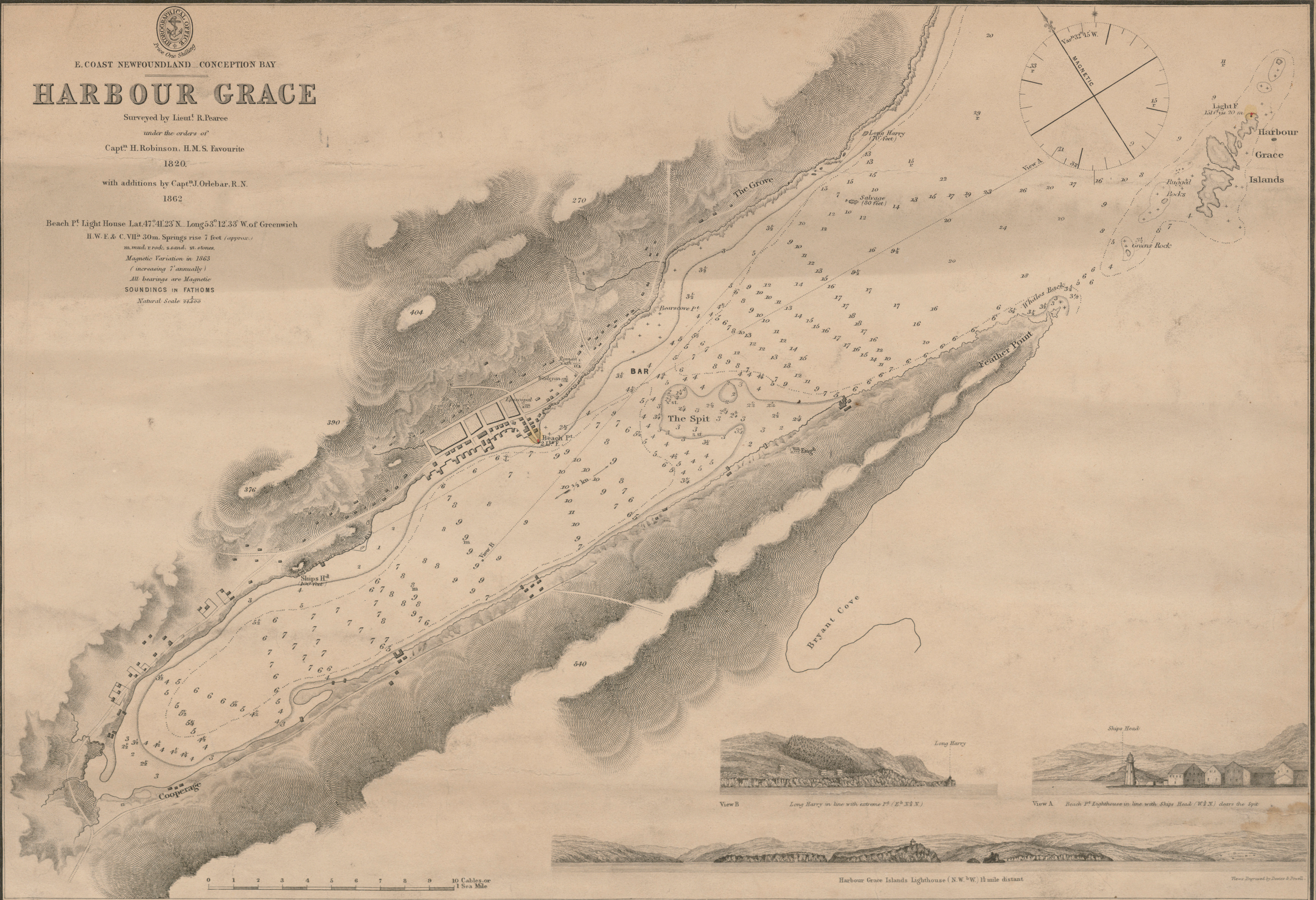
Magnetic Variation in 1863

(increasing 7' annually)

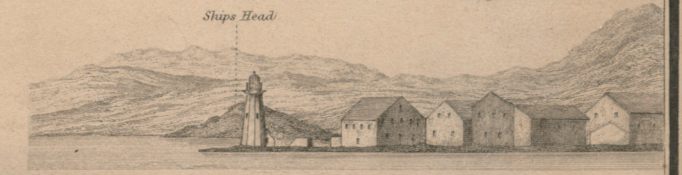
