## SITUATION

- Water levels continue receding. The situation in flooded areas improved significantly during the last days. However some areas are still flooded and a lot of houses need to be cleaned. (See the floodwaters detected by MODIS on 27-27 May and on 2-3 June in the map).
- According to the <u>UN</u> report (as of 3 June), Kopanice, Vidovice, Lepnice and Jenjice in Orasje municipality are still flooded.
- The civil protection authorities are still working in the affected areas (cleaning operations on-going) 384 and 1 persons are accomodated in 42 temporary accommodations. According to the water management authorities, 90 % of the pipes are restored and work sufficiently.
- Rescue operations stopped on 30 May. The number of reported casualties can still not be confirmed. An estimated 1 million people have been affected (see table below).

FORECAST: For the next 5 days no rain is forecast in the area along the river Sava.
