1. Reference is made to monthly personnel procurement reports required by Letter, General Headquarters, Far East Command, APO 500, 200.3 (20 Jun 47), Subject: "Requisition and Procurement of CIC Personnel" dated 20 June 47.

2. It is desired to clarify so much of above references with respect to the reporting of personnel procured from the Zone of Interior. Replacement personnel who are shipped from the Zone of Interior, regardless of whether or not they have been processed through the 4th Replacement Depot, Yokohama, Japan, will be reported as personnel procured from the Zone of Interior. If personnel replacements are temporarily assigned to a Counter Intelligence Corps Detachment subsequent to their departure from the Zone of Interior, and then are eventually transferred to your command, they will not be considered as personnel procured from ZI but will be reported under local procurement as: "Transferred from (indicate the organization)". The source of newly assigned personnel may be determined from transfer orders and/or shipment numbers.

3. With reference to your radiogram ZGBI 1448 dated 9 December 1947, there are no directives issued or policies established by General Headquarters, Far East Command, which preclude the shipment of replacement personnel direct from the Zone of Interior to your command. The statement contained in subject radiogram is not consistent with your November 47 monthly personnel procurement report (Radiogram ZGBI 1417 dated 29 Nov 47) in which it was noted in par 3a therein that 1 Captain, MOS 9302, was procured from the United States. Information available at Headquarters, 441st Counter Intelligence Corps Detachment discloses that Captain Elbert H. Eller, 0388352, was shipped to your command during the month of November, 1947. Shipment number OM-H-135-BL (a) for Captain Eller was reported by General Headquarters, Far East Command, to Department of the Army in radiogram O 57232 dated 10 December 1947.

4. Request that future monthly personnel procurement reports contain proper shipment numbers in applicable instances, and that each report be prepared after 2400 hours of the last day of the month and

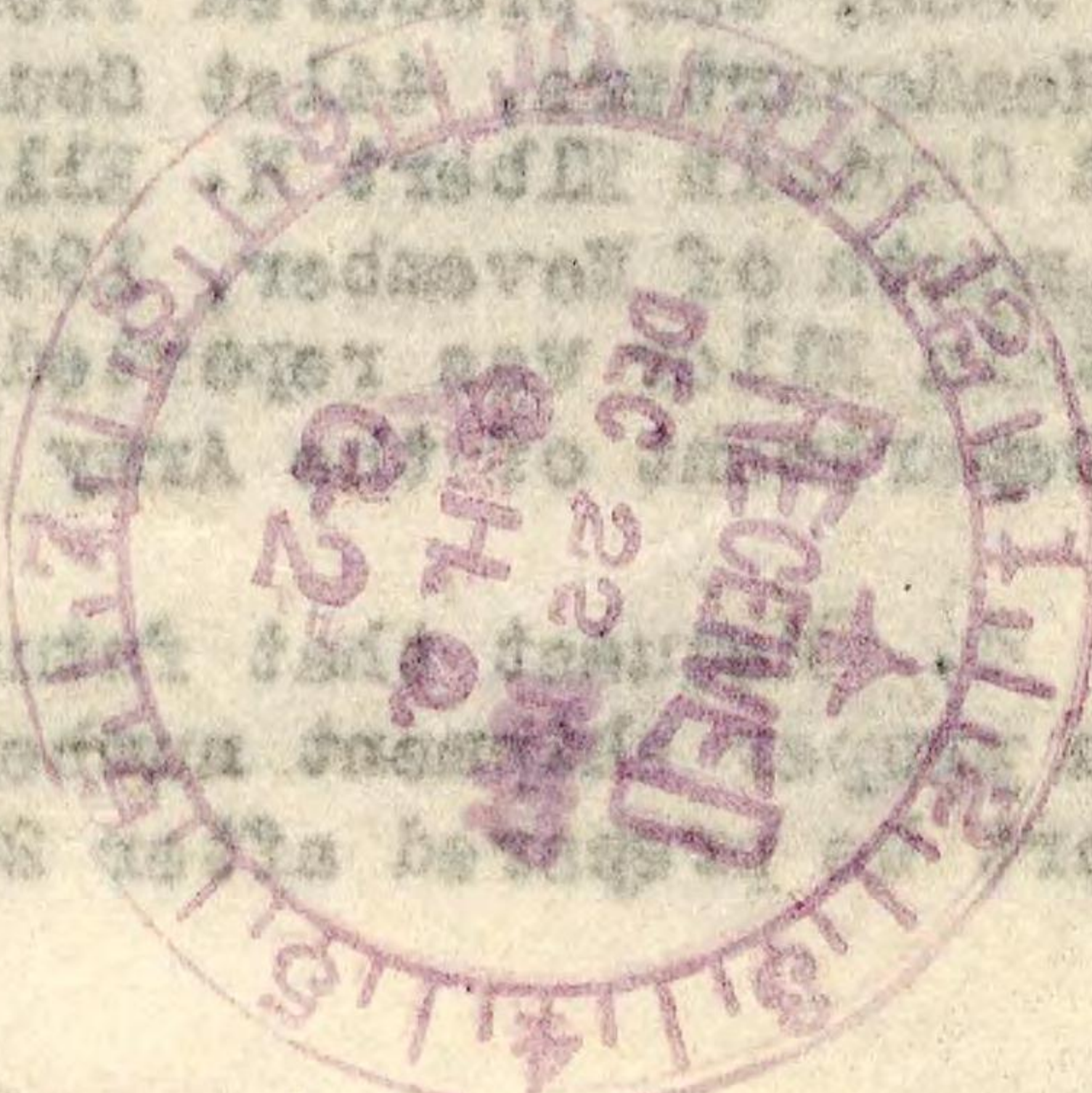
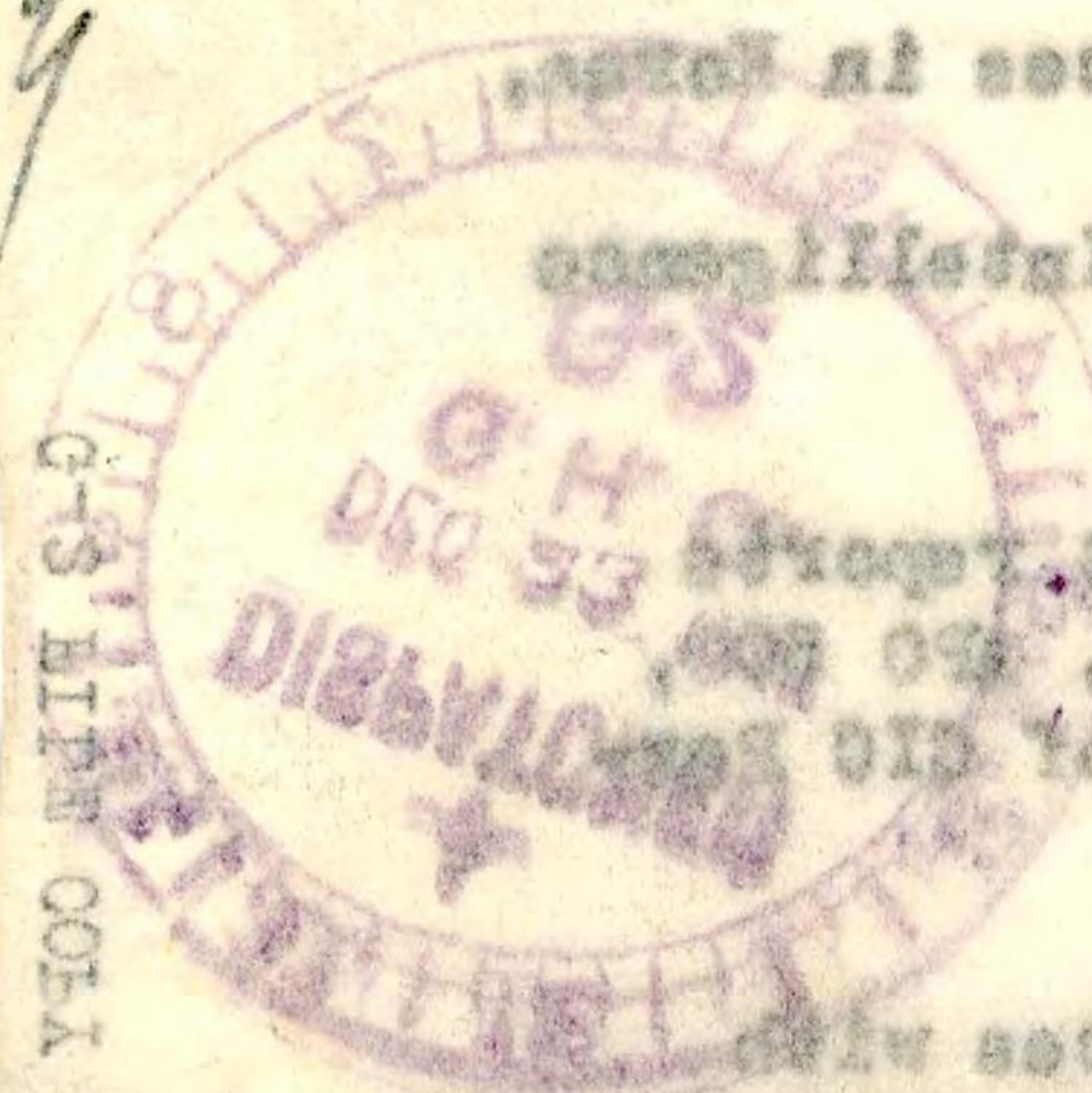

It is desired to clarify to you of above references with
respect to the reporting of personnel procured from the zone of interest.
Personnel who are shipped from the zone of interest, regard-
less whether or not they have been processed through the 4th Regimen-
ment, Japan, will be reported as personnel procured from
the zone of interest. If personnel replacements are temporarily assigned
to a Counter Intelligence Group Detachment assignment to their depots
from the zone of interest, and then are eventually transferred to your
command, they will not be considered as personnel procured from the
zone of interest. Personnel procured from the zone of interest
will be reported under local procurement as "transferred from"
(indicate the organization). The source of newly assigned personnel
may be determined from transfer orders and/or shipment numbers.

With reference to your radiogram RMI 1448 dated 8 December
1941, there are no directives issued or policies established by General
Headquarters, Van East Command, which prohibit the shipment of person-
nel from the zone of interest to your command. The
personnel direct from the zone of interest to your command. The
statement contained in subject radiogram is not consistent with your
November 41 monthly personnel procurement report (Radiogram RMI 1447
dated 20 Nov 41) in which it was noted in par 5 therein that 1 Captain,
PO 338, was procured from the United States. Information available
at Headquarters, Van East Command, Intelligence Group Detachment discloses
that Captain Albert K. Miller, O388302, was shipped to your command during
the month of November 1941. Shipment number OH-148-41 (a) for
Captain Miller was reported by General Headquarters, Van East Command,
to the Army in radiogram C 29238 dated 10 December 1941.
It is noted that your monthly personnel procurement reports con-
tain shipment numbers in appropriate instances, and that such
reports are prepared after 2400 hours of the last day of the month and

1. Reference cited in Par 1, this letter, requires that radio report be submitted by 3rd of each month, reporting strength as of last day of previous month, personnel procured locally, and personnel received from EI with shipment numbers.

2. Nov 47 report submitted by 971 CIC Det should have been prepared as of 2400 hours, 30 Nov 47. However, the radio was received by 971 CIC Det on 29 Nov 47. This radio reported: "Par 3a. Personnel procured from the US, 1 Capt MOS 2802". Shipment number was not indicated. In order to avoid delay in transmission of the consolidated PRC, CIC Detachment report due at G3CIB, Dept of Army, on the 5th of Dec, the report was incorporated with that submitted by 441 CIC Det and dispatched on 5 Dec 47. In radiogram G 57718 dtd 5 Dec 47, GINOW requested the shipment number of the officer reported as procured from US.

3. On 9 Dec 47, 971 CIC Det advised GINOW in radio ZGBI 1248 dtd 9 Dec 47 that: "Due to policy set by FPO, this detachment has received no shipments of personnel direct from the US at any time". This statement is in error as there have been no directives issued by GAO (G-3) prohibiting the shipment of replacement personnel direct from US to 971 CIC Det. Furthermore, the statement is inconsistent with 971 CIC Det's own report which is referred to in Par 1 above.

1. Letter AG 200.3 (20 Jun 47) GB/CIS/CIC, Subject: "Requisition and Procurement of Counter Intelligence Corps Personnel, dated 20 June 47, was dispatched to CG USAFIK, 23 June 1947.
2. This letter mentioned in par 1 emphasized the need for coordination of CIC personnel requirements in the theater and established the procedure so that in accordance with WD policy cited in Radio WAR W 98498 dated 22 May 47, all requisitions for CIC personnel would be submitted by the theater CIC officer to the Adjutant General to insure that CIC officers would be assigned on arrival in this theater where actual shortages exist.

(1) Present CIC tables of organization do not provide mess, supply and motor maintenance personnel or a sufficient number of clerical personnel for units operating independently in the field. To meet the stringent requirements of peace time army administration and housekeeping as well as the conduct of counter intelligence operations at the required level of efficiency, additional administrative personnel are badly needed.

(2) It is believed that CIC applicants should be selected not only for their investigative and linguistic abilities but also for their knowledge of correct usage of the English language in composition. Many good investigators must be trained by the theatre CIC unit to write clear and concise reports of investigations.

b. Education of Staff Personnel

(1) Although TM 30-500 clearly defines CIC duties and also definitely outlines types of duties for which CIC personnel will not be used, there are many cases in which staff officers are not familiar with the mission of the Counter Intelligence Corps and assign jobs which are not in the Counter Intelligence field. To assist further in the elimination of the present misunderstanding, it is recommended that more emphasis be placed on the CIC mission and duties in course of instruction of staff, intelligence, and service schools.

c. Payment of Informants

(1) It is recommended that an overall policy be announced by the Counter Intelligence Corps to provide for the partial payment of informants in standard U. S., supply items, food, rations, etc. purchased from Post Exchanges and Commissaries.

1. The plan as outlined in basic communication is considered sound and should prove valuable to the Counter Intelligence Corps. It will be more effective if the merits of the CIC Specialization of the Military Intelligence Reserve can be pointed out to personnel while they are still in the theater and are actively engaged in operations. Once an agent has returned to civilian life, he might tend to lose interest in investigative activities, unless his civilian capacity is in that field. Many of the men who live in rural areas will lose contact and association with Counter Intelligence unless they are signed up before their return to the Zone of the Interior for separation.

2. It is recommended that a system be established whereby all paper work in connection with signing an agent for CIC Specialization in the Military Intelligence Reserve can be accomplished prior to the agent's departure from the theater. His name and qualification card can be referred to the Commanding Officer of the CIC Reserve Unit nearest the agent's home in the United States, so that necessary follow-up can be effected in the event the agent does not take the initiative to affiliate with the unit and become an active reservist.

3. In view of the current paper shortage in this theater, it is requested that sufficient copies of all data pertaining to the reserve program be forwarded to enable the 441st CIC Detachment to disseminate the information to each of its CI field units.

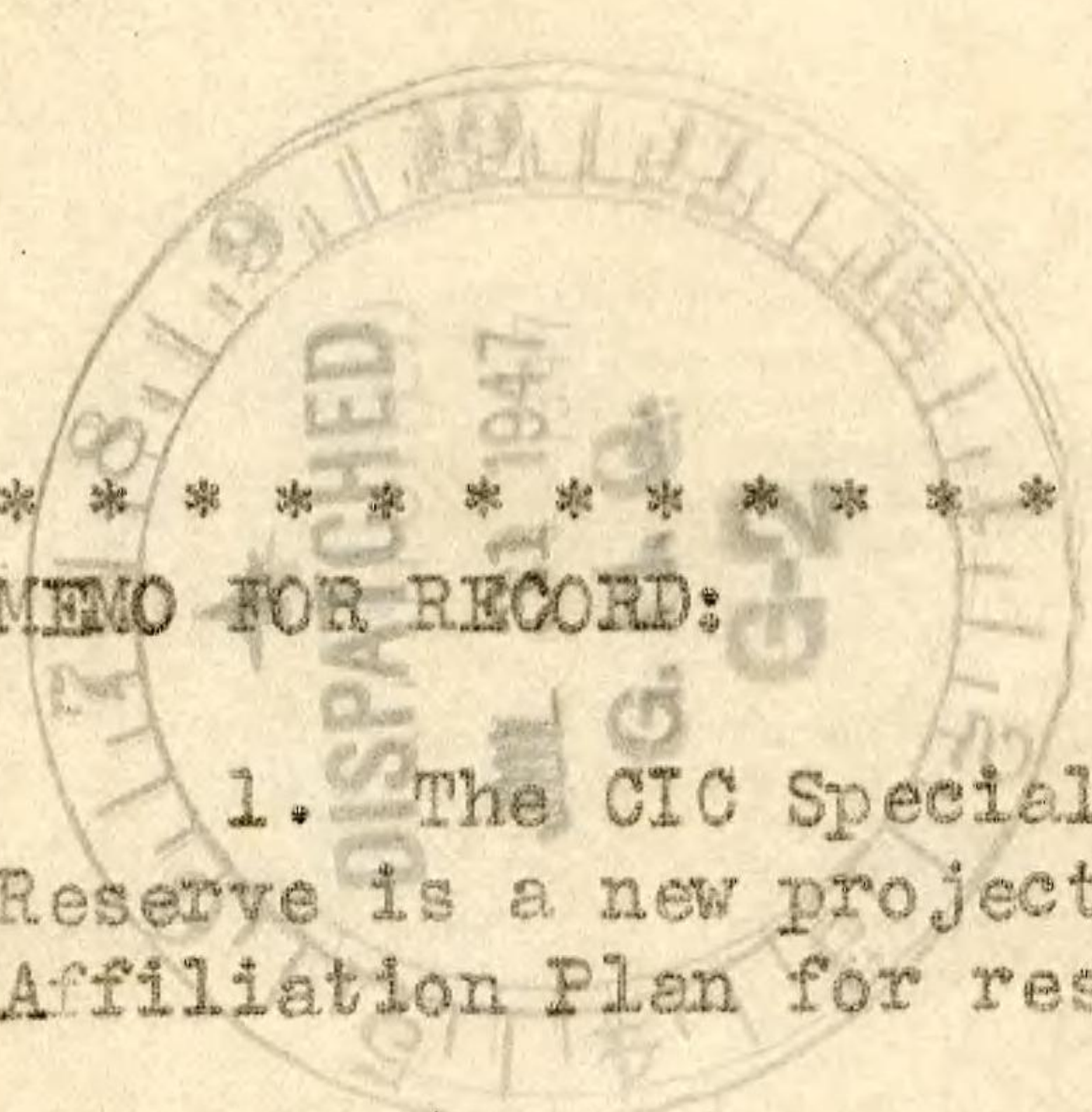

* 1. Basic ltr initiated by WDGID is a routine ltr. Such ltrs of this nature are occasionally received by the 441 CIC Det. when the Intelligence Division files do not show a request for ZI investigations on certain personnel listed in Monthly Administrative Reports. Heretofore, it was believed that ZI investigations on Holabird personnel have either been completed or were in the process of completion prior to the departure of such personnel to overseas assignments. With this understanding the 441 CIC Det had not requested ZI investigations on Holabird graduates. Since this info has proved erroneous and in a number of instances ZI investigations on Holabird personnel have neither been instituted nor completed, the 441 CIC Det. now submits a request for ZI investigations on all individuals immediately upon their assignment to CIC, providing their personnel records contain no evidence of a satisfactory ZI investigations having been completed or in the process of completion.

* 2. 1st Ind prepared by 441 CIC Det. for G-2, is a routine reply to the action taken in the cases of Matsuda and Miyamoto. However, in Miyamoto's case the circumstances were so unusual that it was deemed advisable to query WDGID as to WD's policy with respect to ZI investigations on Holabird personnel.

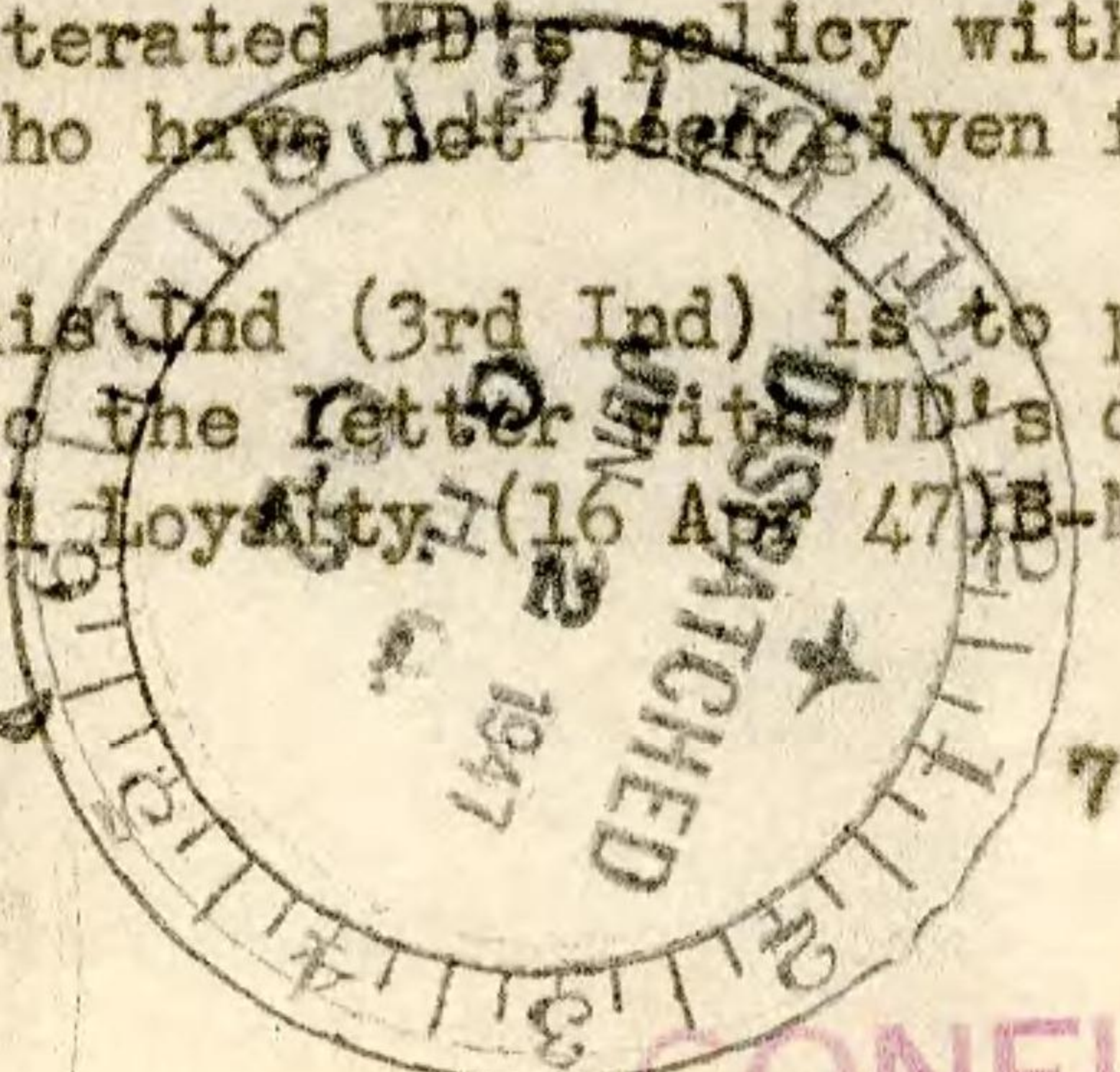

1. Reference par 3 of preceding indorsement, it is impracticable to comply with the policy cited without seriously impairing the operations of the 441st Counter Intelligence Corps Detachment. As of 30 April 47 there were 174 individuals in the 441st Detachment whose files did not contain a letter of clearance for CIC duty (See attached copy of Annex to Monthly Administrative Report of 441 CIC Det., dated 30 April 47, Incl 2).

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BASIC: Ltr, WD, WD, General Staff, Intel., Div., Washington 25, D.C., (24 March 47), dated 24 March 47, subject: Initiation of Investigation for CIC Personnel.

2. Additional information pertinent to the above-mentioned list is furnished as follows:

a. It is noted that some of the individuals included therein have either been assigned to the Counter Intelligence Corps since as early as 1942 when CIC Detachments were activated in combat areas, or have performed cryptographic or highly sensitive duties over extended periods of time. These individuals are presently occupying key positions with the 441 CIC Detachment.

b. A large number of the individuals listed are graduates of the CIC Center, Holabird, Md., and prior to April 1947 no requests for zone of interior investigations were initiated on such personnel. In these instances, and in those cases cited in par 2a above, investigations were not requested because the 441 CIC Detachment had every reason to assume that all such personnel had either been cleared, even though a letter of clearance was not actually in their files, or that an investigation had been initiated prior to their assignment to duty in this theater. Since this assumption apparently was erroneous, appropriate action is being taken by the 441 CIC Detachment to insure that the required loyalty clearance is obtained and entered in the files of the individuals concerned.

c. There are a few individuals listed on whom requests for zone of interior investigations were forwarded to the Intelligence Division as far back as April 1946, and to date no replies have been received as to their disposition.

d. Only since 24 February 1947 has the statement "Investigation relative to qualification for handling of classified material in process of being made" been entered in enlisted men's Service Records by the CIC Center, Holabird, Md. No such entry has been noted on officers' W. D., A.G.O. Forms 66-1.

3. Nearly all of the administrative positions in the 441st CIC Detachment have been filled with qualified personnel. If personnel specially trained for investigative duties by the CIC Center at Holabird, Md. cannot be used for the purpose for which they were sent here until letters of clearance have been received and likewise cannot be used in administrative capacities involving classified information, they are of no value to the CIC Detachment. A survey of correspondence handled within the 441st CIC Detachment shows that 85% contains classified information.

4. The majority of the personnel currently being received from the
