A reliable source of this Bureau has reported that the International News Service at Miami, Florida, is in possession of a story that former President of Cuba Carlos Prío Socarras has stated that the revolution is due any moment in Cuba. It is possible that this statement has been caused by the Cuban Navy sounding an alert on Saturday, June 27, 1953, which alert was sounded because a guard accidentally fired a shot. It has been reported that this Navy alert resulted in numerous rumors over the week end in Havana of impending changes in the Cuban political picture. Sources have advised, however, that as late as Monday, (June 29, 1953) the "situation appears quiet at the moment."
