of Korean Army shall be dispatched to Manchuria and placed under the  
command of the Commander of Kwantung Army.

Infantry	1 brigade (less 1 battalion)
Cavalry	1 company.
Field Artillery	2 companies
Sappers	1 company
Air Force	2 companies
Signals.	1 unit

The above-mentioned units shall enter the command of the  
Commander of Kwantung Army on their crossing of the Yalu River.

The Chief of General Staff shall give instructions with regard  
to details.
