Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry Ordinance No. 27

April 5, 1949

A part of the Regulation on the Adjustment of Demand and Supply of Briquettes (Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry Ordinance No. 16 of 1949) shall be amended as follows:

In Par. 3 of Art. 5, "the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry" shall read "the prefectural governor."

Supplementary Provision:

The present Ministerial Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

Ministry of Commerce and Industry Ordinance No. 15 of 1947 (Matters concerning Items to be handled by the respective Foreign Trade Kodan) shall be partially revised as follows:

In Article 1 "shall handle the following items:" shall be revised as "shall perform the business as prescribed in Article 16, Paragraph 1, Items 1, 2 and 4 of the Foreign Trade Kodan Law as regards the following items:," in the said Article, Item 13 "(including those which neither the Foreign Trade Kodan for Textiles nor the Foreign Trade Kodan for Foodstuffs handles)" shall be revised as "including items not to be handled by the Foreign Trade Kodan for Textiles)" and the following six items shall be added after the said item as from Item 14 to Item 19:

- 14. Staple foodstuffs;
- 15. Beverages and comestibles;
- 16. Oils and fats;
- 17. Fodders;
- 18. Fertilizers;

19. Agricultural, forest, livestock and aquatic products.

The following paragraph shall be added next to Article 1, as Paragraph 2 of the said Article:

The Foreign Trade Kodan for Minerals and Industrial Products shall perform the business as prescribed in Article 16, Paragraph 1, Items 3 and 4 of the Foreign Trade Kodan Law as regards the following items:

- 1. Designated Production Materials (excluding coal, cokes, crude oil and petroleum products) as prescribed by the Regulation concerning the Designated Production Materials Allocation Regulations;
- 2. Iron and steel, non-ferro-metals and manufactures thereof, minerals, chemical products and paper or oil and fat manufactures which do not fall under the preceding item;
- 3. Hairs, bones, horns, teeth, tusks, shells, drugs, pigments, coatings (excluding oil and fat products), textiles and the manufactures thereof, lepironia mats and excelsior.

In Article 2, "shall handle the following items:" shall be revised as "shall perform the business as prescribed in Article 16, Paragraph 1, Items 1, 2 and 4 of the Foreign Trade Kodan Law as regards the following items:"

Articles 3 and 4 shall be deleted.

Supplementary Provision:

The present Ministerial Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation and shall apply as from April 1, 1949.

(C) The area enclosed by the boundary line which, starting from before the Seijo Police Station at No. 802, Unane, Setagaya-ku, Tokyo, goes north along the city road to No. 1,030, 2-chome, Soshigaya, and thence goes west to No. 1,128, Seijo-machi, the same ward by the city road leading thereto, and thence goes south along this city road to No. 543, the same street, and thence goes west along the city road to No. 519, the same street, and thence, across Odawara Express R. R. 



2. Sales terms, etc.

(1) The controlled prices of this list shall include the textile consumption tax and commodity tax.






