PRESS: PRESS CIRCLE PURGEE PLANS ESTABLISHMENT OF
NEW FIRM

Writer states:

"We are now at a loss with both my father and Hidetoshi purged.

"While it seems possible that we can continue to manage the IKUSEI SHA (育生社) company behind the scenes by changing the name of the president, it is anticipated that we may have financial difficulties in the future if we depend only upon the income from this business. Therefore, Hidetoshi is now engaged by himself in preparations for the establishment of a new publishing firm by the name of 'SUZUKA SHOBO' (鈴鹿書房) as a side business."

Examiner's Note: The above mentioned Ikuseisha Company is a publishing firm. Its president is HATTORI Hideo (服部英雄) and the manager HATTORI Hidetoshi (服部英俊). (Source: Who's who in Press Circles, 1943).

N. B. Being a small scale publisher up to Dec. 1941, no chief of department was in existence and the President was in charge of every editorial and planning business. Operation had been run by 5 persons including only one editorial staff member.

Having amalgamated with Goshi Kaisha Kodokaku since Jan. 1942, business has been run under the title of "Ikuseisha-Kodokaku" by nine persons.
