MESSRS. HOVEY invite the attention of their friends and the public to the new edition of their Catalogue. It contains many rare and beautiful novelties, worthy the attention of all amateurs.

Green-house plants of all kinds being grown in pots, they may be transported *at any season of the year*. The season for transplanting the hardy herbaceous plants is *April, May and June*, in the *spring*, and *September, October and November* in the *autumn*. For the South and West, the most favorable period is the autumn, when they may be transported to the most distant parts of the country.

Boxes of plants, or bundles of trees, packed in good order, will be delivered in Boston, *free of expense*, and shipped, or forwarded according to directions. If no directions are given, the best mode of transportation will be selected; but in all cases, the goods are at the risk of the purchaser, and if any delay or loss occurs, after shipment, or delivery at the Express Office or Railroad, the Proprietors do not hold themselves responsible.

All letters of inquiries, or applications for catalogues, to receive attention, should enclose a postage stamp.

☞ All orders for plants, from unknown correspondents, must be accompanied with a draft on Boston or New York, for the amount.

The Nurseries are situated on the Cambridge road to Mount Auburn, half a mile east of Harvard Colleges, about two miles from Boston, and contain upwards of forty acres. All amateurs and lovers of plants are invited to visit the Nurseries.

In the month of May, a splendid collection of Tulips will be in flower. In June, upwards of 1000 varieties of hardy Roses. During the Summer, an unrivalled collection of Paeonies, Phloxes, Verbenas, &c.,—and in September, a magnificent collection of Dahlias and Japan Lilies. In the Conservatory, the Camellias will be in bloom in January; the Azaleas in March; and the Pelargoniums in April and May.

☞ A liberal discount will be made to the trade, and to individuals purchasing large quantities of plants.
