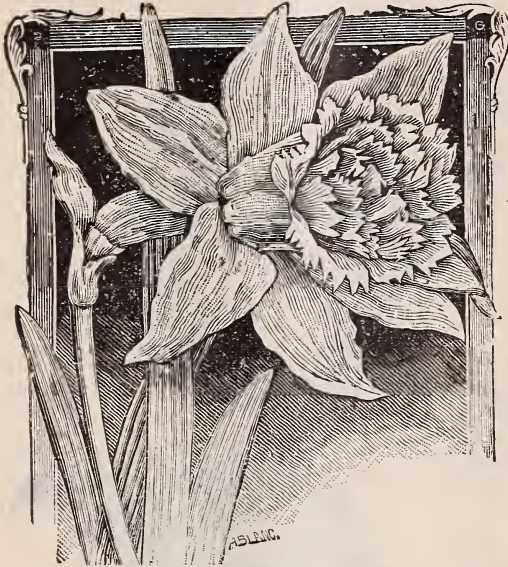

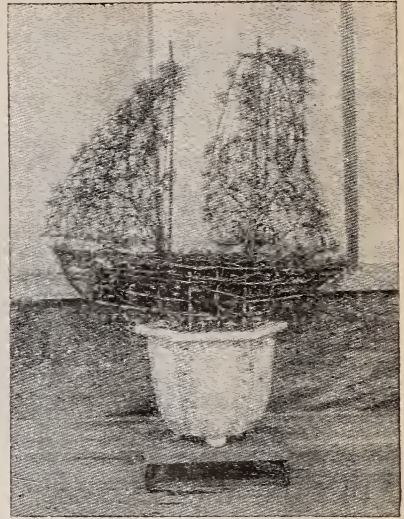

## CALIFORNIA NATIVE BULBS.

These charming and reliable bloomers should be in every florist's collection. They are hardy, extremely easy of cultivation, and adapt themselves to almost any soil and situation. Showy flowers. Main points of cultivation :

(1) Early planting. September to October.

(2) Well-drained, light soil. Sandy loam with leaf-mold is best. Plant 2 to 3 inches deep, 1 to 2 inches apart.

(3) Do not over-water, and do not use any rank manure. All California bulbs force well in boxes or pots.

Ready July to October. 25 at 100 rate, 250 at 1,000 rate, of ONE kind only.

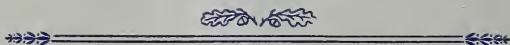
