- Article 1. When the Closed Institution Jutaku Eidan (Housing Corporation) has assigned their ownership of immovables to others, the Special Liquidator may apply for striking out the registration relating to the immovables concerned.
- 2 In case the Special Liquidator applies for striking out the registration concerned in accordance with the provision of the preceding paragraph, he shall state in addition to the application the domicile, name or title of the assignee as well as necessary matters for entering in the land ledger or house ledger.


