SUBJECT : Establishment of Repatriation Mail Service

Between Japan and Northern Korea

1. Reference is made to letter C. L. O. No. 3389 (CC) of 10 July 1946, subject: Establishment of Mail System Between Northern Korea and Japan.

- 2. Reference is also made to Memorandum, General Head-quarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, file AG 311.7 (23 Feb 46) CCS, (SCAPIN 766) subject: Transportation and Handling of Repatriation Mail, authorizing establishment of a limited postal service between Japan and Japanese awaiting repatriation in formerly Japanese occupied areas.
- 3. Mail exchanges between the two zones in Korea have been temporarily suspended due to cholera outbreak in Korea north of 38°. Repatriation mail to addresses in Korea north of 38° may now be dispatched from Japan to Korea south of 38° north latitude for delivery in Korea north of 38° when mail exchanges are resumed. No assurance can be given that such mail will be delivered to the addressees.
