Schedules

The Boston and Maine Railroad endeavors to furnish satisfactory service to its patrons, and you are requested to report, to the Passenger Traffic Mgr., North Station, Boston 14, Mass., any instances of inattention or incivility on the part of its employees. Suggestions for the improvement of the service are always welcome. Every precaution is taken to publish correct schedules, but the times shown cannot be guaranteed. The Company is not responsible for errors in timetables nor for inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections. Although it rarely happens, schedules are subject to change without notice.

TIME from 12:01 midnight to 12:00 noon is shown in light-face figures and time from 12:01 noon to and including 12:00 midnight in bold face figures. Schedules are shown in Eastern Standard Time.

FLAG STOPS: To board train scheduled to stop only on signal (f) or (v) notify Ticket Agent, or if no agent on duty passenger should raise "signal board" on station platform, or give hand signal if no signal board.

To leave train scheduled to stop on signal (f) or (v) notify conductor when boarding train.

Reservations



Reservations and tickets should be purchased as far in advance as possible. When making "name" reservations ascertain time limit space will be held. EASTERN STANDARD TIME applies to time limits. Reservations made more than 14 days in advance will be held until 6:00 p.m. of the 14th day before departure.

RESERVATIONS requested 14 DAYS OR LESS in advance are held as follows depending on whether traveler is near a ticket office. IN TOWN RESERVATIONS will be held until 6:00 p.m. of the following business day. Space requested on same day of departure will be held a reasonable time for ticket purchase.

OUT OF TOWN RESERVATIONS will be held under name until 6:00 p.m. of the 3rd business day including the date space is assigned.

CANCEL SPACE promptly if you change your travel plans by phoning your local agent.

REFUND OF PULLMAN TICKETS WILL ONLY BE MADE WHEN SPACE IS CANCELLED PRIOR TO OR THE DAY BEFORE DEPARTURE and may be obtained through the Ticket Agent. If space is cancelled before one hour of train departure on day of departure, consult Ticket Agent with respect to possibility of exchange and later use of similar space, by purchaser, within 7 days between the same points via the same route. No refund or exchange allowed within one hour of train departure. Any allowable adjustment in fares will be made by Ticket Agent at destination station. Adjustments or complaints are administered by the General Passenger Agent, Pullman Co., Merchandise Mart, Chicago 54, Ill.

Tickets

PLEASE BUY TICKETS before boarding trains. Where station is closed, pay fare on train to conductor and any allowable adjustment in fares will be made by Ticket Agent at destination station.

FEDERAL REVENUE TAX of 10% is imposed on the cost of transportation (when one way fare is 36 cents or more) including cost of seats and berths. No tax on Monthly Commutation tickets. No tax on 12 Ride tickets.

CHILDREN under 5 years of age, when accompanied by parent or guardian, ride free; 5 years of age and under 12, half fare; 12 years of age and older, full adult fare. When seat or berth is occupied exclusively by one or more children under 5 years of age, one half first-class rail fare is required.

MEMBERS OF THE SAME PARTY or family when occupying one or more drawing rooms, compartments, bedrooms, or berths on the same train, extra rail tickets will not be required if the total number of passage tickets presented for each member of the entire family or party is equivalent to the minimum requirements for the exclusive occupancy of the total space occupied by the entire family or party.

FIRST CLASS PARLOR CAR TICKETS are restricted to use in Parlor Cars (applicable only on certain New England railroads) but will be accepted in sleeping cars on collection of a small additional amount to the conductor or Ticket Agent.

PREPAID ORDERS tickets may be provided for friends, relatives, etc. Simply deposit sufficient money with Ticket

Agent to cover cost of Railroad and Pullman tickets, and additional traveling funds. The entire transaction is handled for you by telegraph at no extra cost.

TIME LIMIT of one way tickets is one year. Local tickets valid in either direction. Round Trip Ticket Limits show on face of ticket.

STOP OVERS are allowed on regular one way and round trip Rail tickets, except those sold at special excursion fares within final limit, on notice to Conductor.

Refunds



REFUNDS, ADJUSTMENT OF FARE: In the event of any misunderstanding with Conductor as to proper fare or ticket privileges please pay charge requested, take a receipt and communicate with Passenger Traffic Manager, North Station, Boston 14, Mass. or call at the Travel Bureau, North Station, Boston, Mass. Conductors are not authorized to change rules, or charges.

UNUSED TICKETS or partly used tickets of Boston and Maine R.R. issue may be redeemed at the Travel Bureau, or mailed to Passenger Traffic Mgr., Boston and Maine R.R., North Station, Boston 14, Mass.

NOMINAL SERVICE CHARGE is made for redeeming railroad tickets (except commutation) in accordance with tariff on file with the regulatory commissions. This charge ranges from 10¢ on tickets costing \$1.00 or less to a maximum of 25¢ on tickets costing \$1.15 or more.

A partially used one way or round trip ticket is redeemable at the difference between its cost and the fare applicable to the portion used plus above nominal service charge.

A charge is made when baggage is checked on a ticket not used for passage or when baggage has been carried beyond the point at which journey is discontinued.

Except as otherwise provided by tariff, the rides used on commutation tickets are charged for on the basis of the amounts which would be paid for other one way or commutation tickets to cover such service.

Wholly unused tickets may be redeemed within 30 days from issuing date at ticket office where purchased when presented by the original purchaser.

Baggage



SERVICE CHARGE of 25 cents on each piece of hand baggage and 50 cents on each trunk will be collected at the time of checking the baggage. Hand baggage includes duffel bags, suitcases, brief cases, gun cases, skis, etc. Trunk charges include also cases, crates, large boxes, baby carriages, invalid chairs, etc. The service charge does not include any other charges such as to cover excess valuation, weight, etc.

Checkable baggage consists of wearing apparel, toilet articles (except liquids) and similar personal effects for the passenger's use, comfort and convenience for the purpose of the journey. Liquids, fragile articles, etc., are not checkable baggage. Railroads will not be responsible for loss or damage to/or caused by articles not properly checkable as baggage. Hand baggage in coaches and Pullmans is restricted to what can be conveniently placed in Pullman space or in coach baggage rack over passenger.

Be sure your baggage is clearly marked to show name and permanent address.

Passengers are urged to check baggage a day in advance or so that it may be forwarded on a preceding train, especially from stations that are closed during certain hours of the day, or closed on Saturdays, Sundays or holidays. Where station is closed, and passenger wishes to check baggage, it may be carried on the train and presented to train baggage master for checking to the transfer point of car or railroad where station checking facilities are available for rechecking to destination.

Any single piece may be checked not exceeding 300 lbs. in weight or 72 inches in greatest dimension nor exceeding \$2500 in value for any single shipment. Free allowance of 150 lbs. per adult ticket, subject to tariff regulations, is granted with \$100 maximum declaration (in writing on form prescribed), or extra value may be declared at low rate.

Baggage for stations where no agent is on duty (inquire on checking baggage) must be claimed at Baggage Car immediately on arrival at that station; otherwise it will be carried to first station where agent is on duty and will be held for further orders.

Every effort will be made to facilitate delivering baggage, but no guarantee can be given that it will be forwarded on same train carrying owner, nor can time of arrival at destination to which checked be guaranteed.

STORAGE will be charged on each piece of baggage inbound or outbound checked or unchecked remaining on hand over 24 hours.

TRANSFER IN BOSTON: The Armstrong Transfer Co. will transfer baggage to or from railroad stations, residences, hotels and docks. Charges vary from 80¢ up. Similar service available in other large cities.

INSURE YOUR BAGGAGE AND PERSONAL EFFECTS — A short-term policy of the St. Paul Fire & Marine Insurance Company, insuring all baggage taken on a trip, whether worn, carried or checked, may be purchased at principal stations on the Boston and Maine Railroad. The coverage is liberal and the rates are low. Minimum premium 25¢. Ask Ticket Agents for particulars.

RED CAP BAGGAGE — A service charge of 25¢ per piece is made by this and most other railroads for handling hand baggage and other articles. This charge is collected by Red Cap porters at the time passengers offer their hand baggage or parcels for handling. Charge will apply each time service is performed.

RAILWAY EXPRESS SERVICE also available for nation-wide delivery service.



PETS accompanying passengers: Small dogs, cats or other small animals (not vicious, odoriferous or otherwise objectionable) when carried in closed basket or containers may be taken in railroad coaches, also in private room accommodations. Not more than two animals may be taken in any one room. The animals must be in suitable containers when taken to and from the rooms; however, dogs may be on leash and muzzled in lieu of in container. Dogs properly muzzled and provided with strong, securely fitting collar or harness on chain, or other strong leash, or enclosed in crates, will be checked in baggage service at tariff rates. The law requires any dog checked to a destination in Massachusetts from outside the state shall be accompanied by a health certificate approved by the livestock official of the state of origin showing dog to be free from contagious diseases, and has not been exposed to rabies. No pets allowed in dining or restaurant cars.

WESTERN UNION TELEGRAPH CO. handles messages at station telegraph offices. Special blanks are available on Pullman Sleeping Cars and Parlor Cars for dispatching messages from trains with charges collected at destination.

TRAVELERS CHEQUES — When you purchase your ticket it is possible to protect the funds you carry with you on your journey by changing your cash into American Express Travelers Cheques. The charge for these Cheques is only 75¢ for each \$100 purchased. If they should be lost or stolen before you have signed them the second time, the American Express refunds the amount involved.

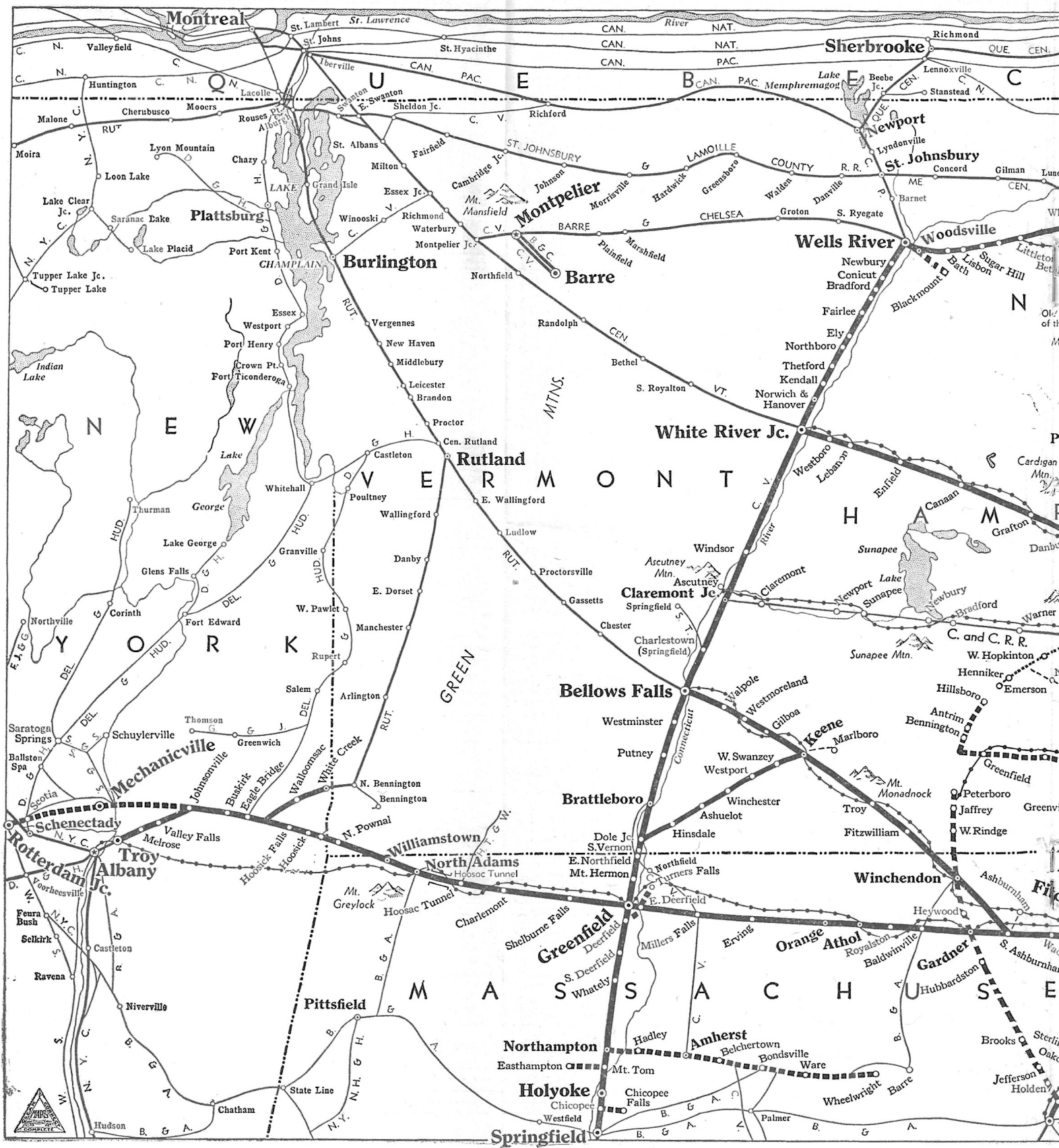

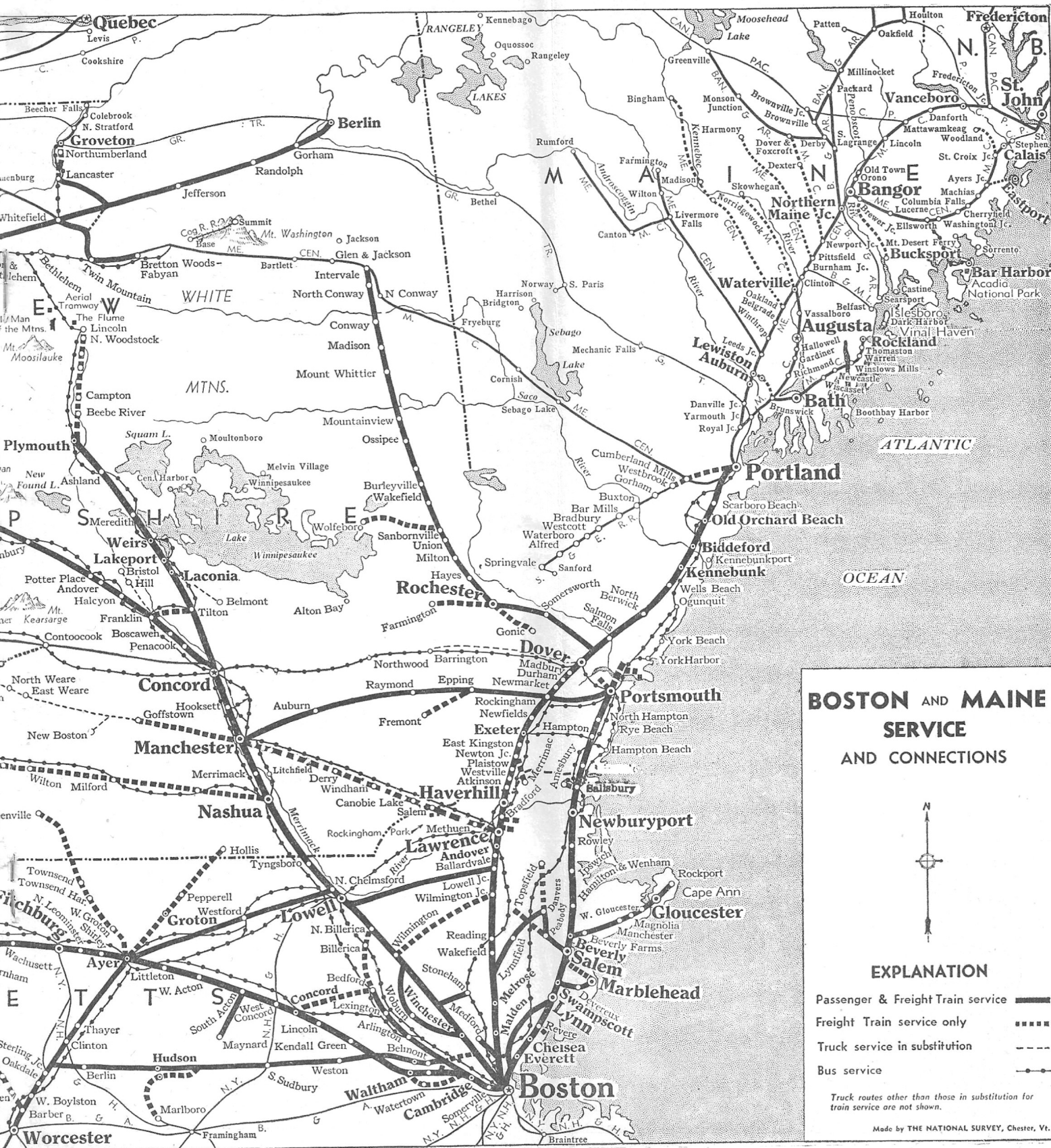
