**Extras on Cash Orders:** On cash orders of \$2.00 to \$5.00 you can select 10% extra in bulbs of your own choosing. From \$5.00 to \$25.00 select 15%, \$25.00 to \$50.00 select 20% and above \$50 select 25%. These discounts do not apply to collections.

Also on orders of \$25.00 to \$50.00 I will put in a blooming size bulb of Solveig extra.

On cash orders of \$10.00 or more, except collections, I will give a copy of the "Gladiolus Book" by Rockwell, if you ask for it.

Packages of bulblets run from twenty-five to fifty or more. We give very good value on these packages.

You can have 3 bulbs at the 10 rate; 25 at the 100 rate. But no single item for less than 10 cents.

I Guarantee Satisfaction and I mean just that. If at anytime, either after receiving the bulbs or after blooming, you have cause for complaint just write me about it and I will do my utmost to make things right. This is the only basis on which anyone can hope to conduct a business that will be permanently successful.

The above discounts and extras are all for cash orders. The earlier the orders are received and the larger they are the more generous we will be with our extras. If you want to get your order in and cannot spare all the cash now send 25% and the balance later and we will see that you are satisfied. But the above extras are only for Cash before shipment.

At these prices all bulbs are **prepaid** anywhere in the United States and Canada and all countries in the Postal Union.

When there is a figure before prices (as 2-.10, 2-.15, etc.) it means two bulbs for .10 or two bulbs for .15 as the case may be.

For the benefit of our Canadian customers I will accept Canadian money at par for anything from the retail part of my catalog. Also for the benefit of our customers in Australia and New Zealand will accept money from those countries at par, at the par value of the pound sterling, that is, counting the pound as valued at \$4.80 of our money. This for bulbs at retail, not from the wholesale pages of the list.

In buying bulbs do not worry too much about price. Aside from the price of the bulbs you should consider quality, count, the reliability of the grower, etc. I always try to put in enough extra count or over size to make up for any lower price that other good reliable growers might make. I cannot actually put up every order myself but I do go over every order before it is filled to see that my customers get the worth of their money and then some. Just leave it to me.

If You Want to Pay Transportation and get extra count on your order just mention it and I will send your order collect and will see that you are more than satisfied. Just say whether you want extra count on your order or extras in other kinds and what kinds. If you send postage to prepay your order be sure to send enough. Some people send about half enough and expect us to pay the rest and give extra bulbs besides. If you want bulbs sent by mail and you want to pay postage it is better to send C. O. D. for the postage.

**On Fair Sized Orders, Express** is safest and best especially in the winter time. I advise express if you are situated so as to get free delivery by the express company.

#### GOOD THRIP NEWS

I believe that thrip can be controlled. For the past two or three years many people in various parts of the country have had trouble raising glads on account of the depredations of a minute insect called the thrip. This insect sucks the juices from the buds so that the flowers do not open up. At first people thought the failure of the buds to open was caused by dry weather but it was really caused by this minute insect. It is so small that many people did not notice it. The adult insects are about one-sixteenth of an inch long, black in color with a yellow stripe across the back. When plants are badly infested you see these running around on the leaves and buds. The young thrip are yellowish in color and are found mostly under the sheaths of the buds and in the axils of the leaves.

At first no one knew what to do to get rid of them. Many people became discouraged in raising glads because the blooms were all spoiled before they opened up. However, now I think that by using all the knowledge that we have about this pest, that it can be controlled and we can grow good glads.

To Avoid the Thrip I would follow this procedure. In the fall after digging your bulbs I would scatter napthalene flakes over them putting a paper or something else over them to confine the fumes. Keep them in a fairly warm place for three weeks or so, then shake the napthalene off and store the bulbs in a cool cellar. If you have small lots they can be kept in paper bags with some napthalene in the bags and tied up tight. The fumes will surely kill the insects but the flakes should be left on long enough, about three weeks, for any eggs to hatch out. If kept in a cold place the eggs will not hatch in this length of time For that reason the bulbs should be kept fairly warm.

If you can't get napthalene flakes at your druggist I will send you enough for about two thousand bulbs for \$.50 prepaid. You should use about one ounce to one hundred large bulbs. A little more or less is all right.

Before planting the bulbs again by all means either put on napthalene flakes again under the same conditions as in the fall or disinfect the bulbs with some strong disinfectant like lye or Bichloride of Mercury. If lye is used I would use one can of commercial lye to twenty gallons of water and soak the bulbs over night. If you use Bichloride of Mercury use one ounce to eight or ten gallons of water and soak for three or four hours or longer. I most earnestly urge everyone to disinfect their bulbs before planting so they can be absolutely sure that the bulbs are clean. It doesn't matter if they are your own bulbs and you have never seen any thrip in your fields or not, I would surely disinfect them.

The next step is beginning when the plants are four or five inches high, to spray them about once a week with the following formula: two heaping tablespoons of Paris Green, one and one half pints of molasses and three gallons of water. Put this on as a sort of mist and not so heavy that it runs down the stem. There are proprietary sprays on the market that can be used but I have heard of just as good results from the use of the Paris Green and molasses as from anything. This spray makes the plants a rather sticky mess but when they get ready to bloom the spraying can be stopped and the plants sprayed off with water or if you should get a rain it would clean them up. After that I don't believe you would have any trouble with the thrip.

It is true, I have heard from some people who said they disinfected their bulbs and sprayed besides and still had the thrip. Of course thrip can come from outside sources as it often does but I believe in most cases where people have apparently done everything to avoid the thrip and still have them, that some of the operations of spraying or disinfecting were not done thoroughly enough or the spraying was not begun early enough. I firmly believe that if we disinfect our bulbs and spray them right from the start when the plants are small and do it about once a week that we will not be troubled with the thrip as I have heard from many people who have done this and have had the finest glads they ever had, though last year they didn't cut a good bloom.

For large growers who have quantities of glads the napthalene flakes would probably be too much bother to use. Growers with rooms or storage houses devoted entirely to glads can fumigate with Cyanogas or some other fumigant. This would be as effective and easier to use than the napthalene.
