



Aotearoa was settled by peoples from the oceans of Moana-nui-a-Kiwa, the great oceans of Kiwa (also the Pacific Ocean). They came from East Polynesia between 1250 and 1300 CE in waves of migration. The people are Māori and the language is te reo Māori.




Improving coverage of New Zealand's National Parks a Wikipedia article can bring information together to create an accessible and easy-to-navigate resource
