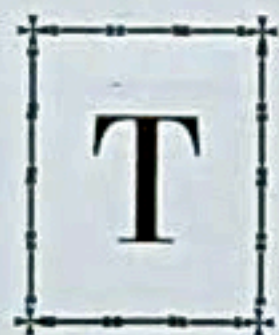

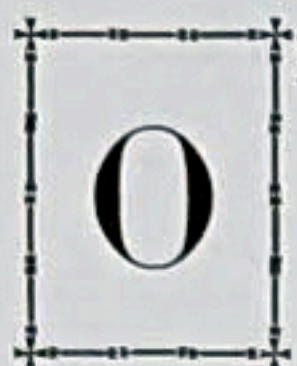

These windows are not to be confounded with the "mill" products which are frequently met with.

The coloring is carefully thought out by the artist in charge, and at a small cost per window the humblest mission church can be beautified.

We supply these windows at very reasonable prices, and finish them, as we do all our work, in the best possible workmanship, so that they will last as long as the building stands.
