This plant identified as a producer of electronics equipment by A.I.C., was found to be the, "Sonoike tool mfg. Co. ltd."

Functions of this plant included production of small tools, gas meters, and as metalurgical research.

There were 6 branch factories three built in 1943 and three in 1945. The new branches were not in full production by the end of the war.

In march of this year dispersal of machines from the main factory was begun.

6 wooden buildings were destroyed within the plant area by the fire raid of 25 May 1945.

These buildings were, the gas meter mfg. bldg., the research laboratory, the forge, two office buildings, and one commercial school.

One fire bomb penetrated the concrete roof of the main building but did no other damage.

It was found that the larger portion to the north was a Private Sanitarium for the insane, the smaller portion was the village school.

The area designated as the vital area and inclosing the aiming point was the doctors office at the sanitarium.

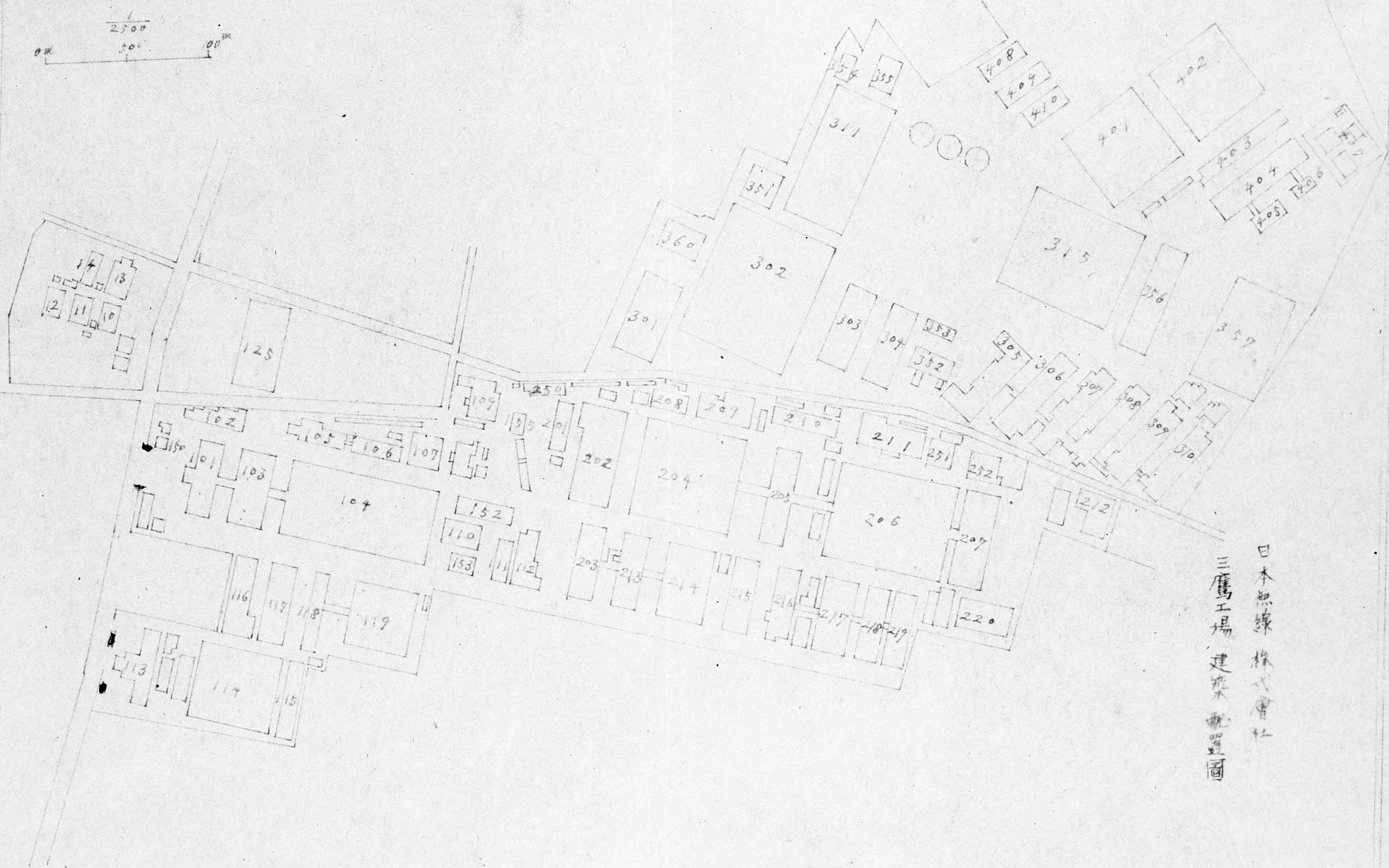
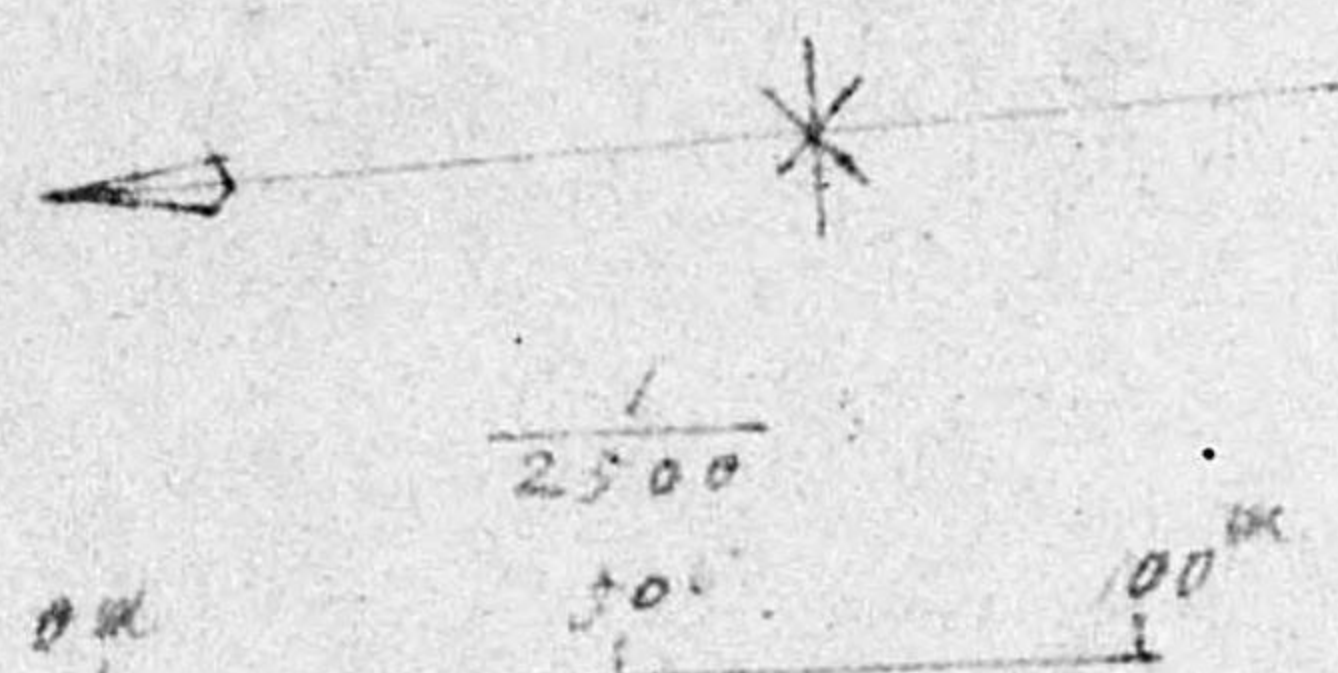

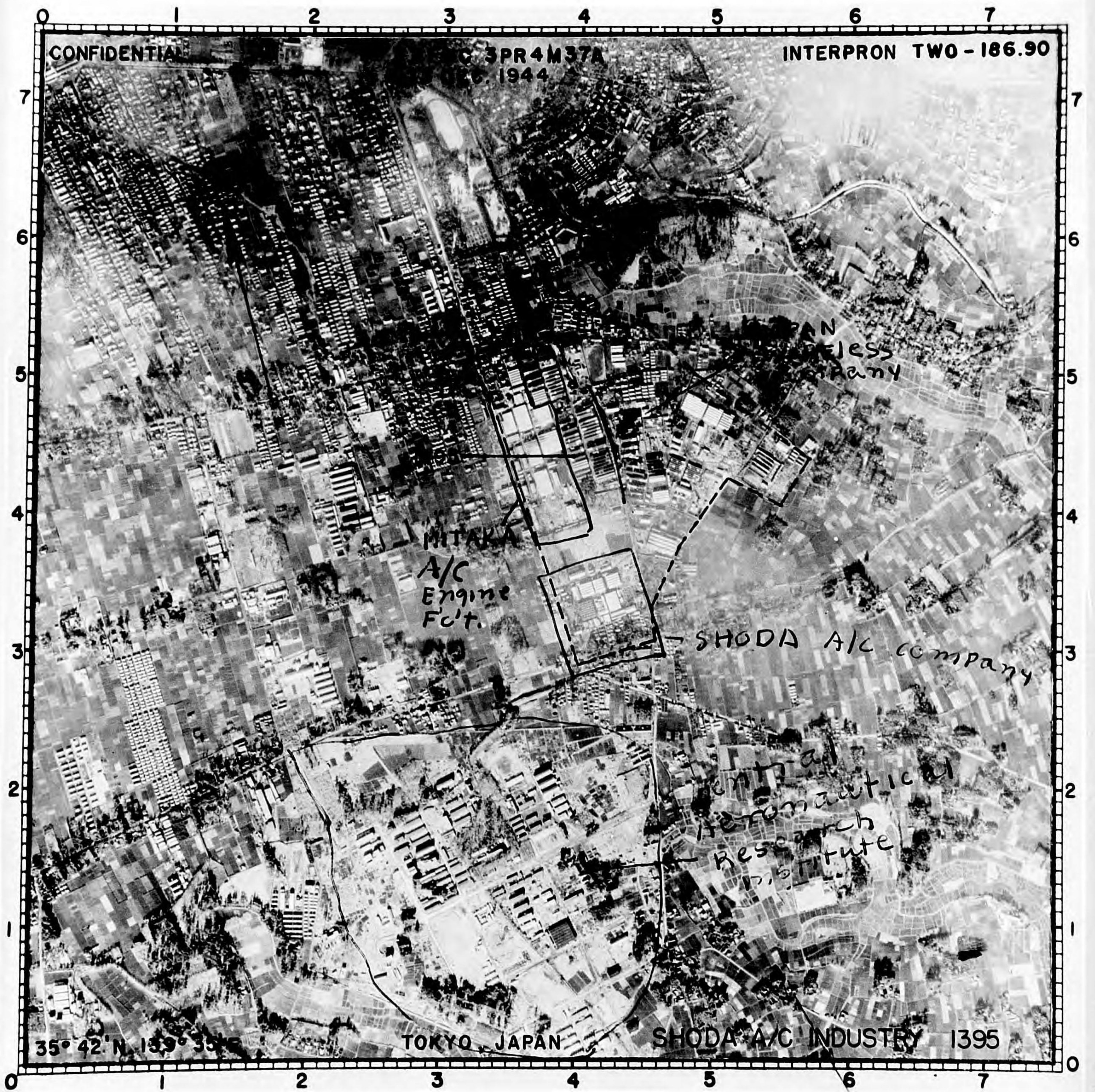
