


Comma Definition


a punctuation mark (,) indicating a pause between parts of a sentence. It is also used to separate items in a list.










USE TO SEPARATE TWO INDEPENDENT

Comma Splice INCORRECT:



school bus was late

CORRECT:

It was raining. The school bus was late
