In accordance with the provisions of paragraphs of 3 a and 3b of Directive No. 3 from the Supreme Commander for the Allied powers, dated 22 September 1945; Memorandum for the Imperial Japanese Government, Subject: Reconversion of War Production Plants to peacetime Production, dated 28 October 1945; and under authority Granted this Headquarters by CINCPACRADIO BAX6197 dated 3 October 1945, You are authorized to commence operation of your plant, and to manufacture the essential civilian commodities listed in Annex No. 1 to this permit.

1. Reference, letter, Headquarters I Corps, file no. AG 004 (Rep) - BA, subj: Review of Selected Plants, dated S-10 April 1 47.

2. Nankai Tekko Co. Ltd. is not recommended for inclusion in the reparations program for the following reasons:

a. This plant does not fit the criteria established for the aircraft industry, for this company never produced any parts of an aircraft.

b. This plant does not fit the criteria established for the privately owned munitions plant for the reason that the plant was not originally organized for munition production nor was it converted for munition production through such major change in the volume and character of their equipment as to render them unsuitable for reconversion to peace time purposes.

c. This plant was organized in 1924, and since that time engaged in manufacturing parts for the bicycle hub. During the war, it manufactured some parts for the fuses of various projectiles, in addition to the bicycle. However, immediately after the war it returned to its peace time production of bicycle hubs, parts for doors and window locks, and spark plugs for automobiles.

3. No new machines or techniques were involved in the production of fuses nor was it difficult to change from war time production to peace time production.

4. The majority of the machines of this plant are at least 22 years old. A small amount of bench lathes were purchased approximately nine years ago. All in all, the machines are pretty old.
