1 Mr. Masten: The persons whose names I first read were  
2 in the Office of Chief of Naval Operations.

3 Senator Ferguson: That is in Admiral Stark's office?

4 Mr. Masten: Presumably Admiral Stark's office, although  
5 the memorandum does not so state.

6 Senator Ferguson: Does it say where they were?

7 Mr. Masten: I am advised that the officers whose names  
8 were first read were on duty in Admiral Stark's office.

9 To go on, there was no watch maintained in that office  
10 after working hours at that time.

11 Senator Ferguson: Will you find out for us what were  
12 the working hours in Admiral Turner's office?

13 Mr. Masten: We will ask the Navy what the expression  
14 "working hours" on that day is.

15 That is all we have.

16 Senator Ferguson: You did not give us the Navy Intelligence.  
17 I will now make the request that you get the same kind of informa-  
18 tion on Navy Intelligence.

19 Mr. Masten: We will ask the Navy where that is.

20 The Vice Chairman: Is that all?

21 Mr. Masten: Yes.

22 The Vice Chairman: The committee stands adjourned until  
23 10 o'clock in the morning.
