Integrated editing of templates with structured and unstructured data

Design exploration

Would it be possible to reuse template editor dialogs to deal with structured data?

The main challenge is dealing with both kinds of data (structured and plain text) and encourage users to migrate.

A couple of design explorations illustrate ideas to support that.
