## INTRODUCTION

The work of photographers under the direction of Roy Stryker for the Resettlement Administration, the Farm Security Administration and the Office of War Information is already famous as a sociological and economic survey of the United States during the period 1935-1943. Prints have been widely exhibited and published in books and periodicals for a great variety of purposes. This collection now forms the nucleus of the Library of Congress Photograph Section and it has, during the past two years, undergone extensive reorganization. These microfilms represent both a stage in the reorganization and a means for low-cost distribution of reproductions from which prints for publication may be ordered. For understandable reasons, it is impossible to provide a detailed index to individual prints. This index, therefore, is intended to bring out the principal subjects in entire "lots" or groups of photographs which have been arranged to correspond roughly with the original assignments of the photographers. It likewise serves as an aid in locating specific lots within the whole series of microfilms.

Even without the microfilms, the index may be used to determine the general scope of the first part of the collection to be organized. There are four sequences, all determined by work stages during reorganization:

- Lots 1-299. Miscellaneous lots, in the order in which they were organized without logical sequence. Mainly photographers' assignments of 1942 during the last stages of Farm Security Administration photography and the initial state of Office of War Information work.
- Lots 300-656. Resettlement Administration and Farm Security Administration photographic survey of America, 1935-1941, in this regional sequence: Far West, Northwest, Southwest. A loose logical arrangement has been maintained within each state. The states are in geographical rather than alphabetical order.
- Lots 659-999. Miscellaneous lots, in the order in which they were organized. OWI photographers' assignments, 1942-43, with the addition of other material collected rather than photographed by OWI.
- Lots 1000-1737. Resettlement Administration and Farm Security Administration photographic survey of America, 1935-1941: Middle West, Northeast, Southeast.

Approximately 100,000 photographs on 100 reels of positive microfilm appear in these first 1737 lots. The reels, each of which runs to 100 feet of film, contain from 15 to 20 lots of varying length, since the size of any one lot is determined by the number of photographs it contains. The individual lots are identified by a large number on the initial frame. The following frame, in each case, is a copy of a brief description of the lot, indicating its source and scope. There are 4 blank frames between lots, as an aid in "flashing" or locating a desired number in the middle of a reel by rapidly running the film through a projector while counting the flashes. The five irrelevant photographs which appear in the leader of many reels are printing tests. Lot numbers which do not appear in the index have not been microfilmed, as they were used for

temporary storage. Within each lot the prints are arranged in loose editorial sequence. The captions and negative numbers appear on the film with each photograph.

The lots may be ordered on positive microfilm by the numbers which appear at the end of each entry in the index. They may be purchased either individually or in continuous sequence. Once the microfilm lots have been examined, single prints may be selected from them. When ordering prints by listing the negative numbers, please be sure to indicate the series (FSA, OWI, etc.) to which the negative number belongs. For further information concerning the procurement of 8 x 10 prints, which are made from the original negatives, write to the Photograph Section, Library of Congress, Washington 25, D.C.

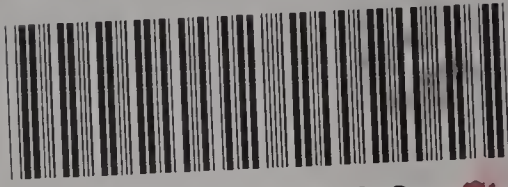
