EXPORTS. The following table shows the value of exports from the United States during the month of October, 1914, compared with the same month of 1913, and with the corresponding months of 1914. The total value of exports for October, 1914, was \$1,000,000,000, compared with \$900,000,000 in 1913, and \$950,000,000 in 1914.

MARINE NEWS

ARRIVALS. The following table shows the arrivals of ships at New York Harbor during the month of October, 1914, compared with the same month of 1913, and with the corresponding months of 1914. The total number of arrivals for October, 1914, was 100, compared with 90 in 1913, and 95 in 1914.
