Roles of contribution

- Descriptive markup (content)
 - Facts, figures, spelling and grammar fixes, etc.
 - Moderate expertise in Wikitext required
- Presentation markup (html, css)
 - Placement and styling of tables, images
 - Moderate expertise in HTML/CSS required
- Procedural markup (templates)
 - Creating info-boxes, citations, notices, etc.
 - Significant expertise in Wikitext required


Why is visual editing so hard?

- **Commingling**
 - Description, presentation and procedural information are mixed together
- **Ambiguity**
 - Multiple styles of syntax can result in the same HTML output
 - Parsing doesn't happen semantically - we don't know what is creating what where and how, it's just a macro expander and a pile of regular expressions

His later films often have elements of surrealism and expressionism eschewing structured linear narrative. 


