- Has network (eIFL) that may be useful in reaching out to individuals in developing countries for the strategy project

- Very interested in the growth of Wikipedia in smaller languages and in developing countries
- Focus on OER:
- Wikimedians are collaborating on OER projects. Importance of building coalitions on the ground to advocate for public access to publicly funded educational materials.
 - There are a number of national OER projects (Brazil, Poland, the Netherlands) where Wikimedians are already playing a leading role
- Connexions platform is a popular platform and there may possibilities for collaboration between WMF and Connexions.
- Collaboration with Wikimedia and libraries could foster work in those languages
- Potential challenge to OER from textbook publishers
- Public Library of Science (an Open Access publisher) partnered with WMF on a survey of academics' use of Wikipedia
- Potential networks for tapping into non-users, readers in developing countries:
- eIFL network – Electronic Information for Libraries - could assist with Wikipedia Academies in developing and transition countries.
